

ISRAEL SENDROVIC has been appointed Senior Vice President. A facsimile of his signature appears on page 5 of the pamphlet.


MARY R. CLARKIN, formerly Assistant Vice President, has been appointed Vice President. A facsimile of her signature appears on page 7 of the pamphlet.


