# **Election of Class B Director**

(By member banks classified in Group 3 on October 23, 1987, that is, member banks with capital and surplus of less than \$30,000,000 on that date)

To the Member Banks of the Second Federal Reserve District:

In accordance with the provisions of section 4 of the Federal Reserve Act, as amended, and Circular No. 10199, dated October 23, 1987, on the nomination of a class B director of this Bank for a three-year term ending December 31, 1990, there is shown on pages 2 and 3 the names of the candidates nominated for such office, and by whom nominated.

To each member bank classified in Group 3 on October 23, 1987, the following are being sent with this circular:

- (a) Ballot for use in voting for candidate for class B director.
- (b) Pink ballot envelope in which the ballot is to be sealed.
- (c) Certificate envelope bearing on its face the certificate in regard to the vote.
- (d) Addressed envelope in which all of the foregoing should be returned to me.

The ballot and the certificate on the certificate envelope must be executed by an officer who has been authorized to cast the vote. A list of the officers designated for this purpose by the member banks in Group 3 was contained in the above-mentioned circular dated October 23, 1987, and a similar list revised to date is contained herein. In order that the ballot may be secret, the name of the bank and the name and title of the voting officer should not be written on the ballot, but should be written only on the certificate envelope.

- (1) The ballot should be marked.
- (2) The marked ballot should be placed in the pink ballot envelope and that envelope sealed.
- (3) Then the sealed pink ballot envelope should be placed within the certificate envelope, and the certificate envelope should be sealed and the certificate thereon executed.
- (4) Then the certificate envelope containing the sealed pink ballot envelope should be returned to me in the enclosed addressed envelope.

The law provides that the ballot shall be cast within 15 days after receipt of the list of candidates transmitted herewith. The polls will open at 10 a.m., November 30, 1987, and will close at 12 noon on Tuesday, December 15, 1987, and in order to be counted as valid the ballot must be received by me at or before the latter time. Upon the closing of the polls the ballot box will be opened in the board room of this Bank, the sealed envelopes containing the ballots will be opened, the votes counted and checked by tellers, and the result of the election announced. The candidates may, if they so desire, be present or represented on this occasion.

Because banks in Groups 1 and 2 will not vote in this election, this circular is sent to them without forms and for their information only.

### JOHN E. MACK III

JOHN E. MACK III was born in Poughkeepsie, New York on February 20, 1934. He received a B.S. degree in finance in 1956 and an M.B.A. degree in 1966, both from Siena College.

Mr. Mack joined the Accounting Department of Central Hudson in 1958, serving in several positions within the Accounting, Financial, and Personnel functions of the Company prior to being promoted to the position of Personnel Director in 1970. He was promoted to Assistant Vice President in 1972, Vice President-Corporate Services in 1974, Vice President-Customer Services in 1976, and Executive Vice President in 1979. He became a director in 1981 and was appointed President in 1982 and Chief Executive Officer in 1986.

He is a member of the Edison Electric Institute and the American Gas Association, trade associations of the utility industry. He is also a member of the Executive Committees of the New York Power Pool and The Energy Association of New York State.

Mr. Mack is Vice Chairman of the Board of the Youth Resource Development Corporation, Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Mount Saint Mary College, and a member of the Executive Committee of the Dutchess County Boy Scouts of America. He is the President of the Board of Directors of the Astor Home for Children, a director of the Children's Home of Poughkeepsie, a trustee of St. Francis Hospital, a member of the Advisory Board of the Rehabilitation Programs, Inc., and a member of the Dutchess Lighthouse Advisory Committee, the board of the Hudson River Valley Association, and the Board of Trustees of the Hudson Valley Philharmonic.

He has served as President of the Dutchess County United Way and the Mid-Hudson Civic Center and as a member of the Orange County Partnership. He was also Chairman of the Board of the Dutchess County Chapter of the American Heart Association and currently serves as Board Member of the New York State Affiliate of the American Heart Association. Mr. Mack is Chairman of the New York State Advisory Board and a member of the Poughkeepsie Advisory Board of the Salvation Army. He is Chairman of the City of Poughkeepsie Tricentennial Committee and has served as a captain in the U.S. Army.

He is also a member of The Bank of New York Northern Division Advisory Board, but will resign from that position if elected.

Mr. Welch joined General Electric in 1960, becoming Vice President and Group Executive for components and materials in 1973 and Senior Vice President and Sector Executive for consumer products and services in 1977. In 1979, he was elected Vice Chairman of the Board and in 1981 became Chairman of the Board and Chief Executive Officer.

He is a member of the Business Council and the Business Roundtable, and chairman of the National Academy of Engineering.

Mr. Welch is now a Class B director of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York, having been elected for the three-year term ending December 31, 1987.
