Whitestone Savings, F.A.

We have been advised that effective March 16, 1990, the Director of the Office of Thrift Supervision, Department of the Treasury, determined that a ground for the appointment of a receiver existed for Whitestone Savings, F.A., Whitestone, New York ("Old Whitestone"). The Resolution Trust Corporation ("RTC") was appointed receiver for the purpose of liquidation. Whitestone Federal Savings and Loan Association, Whitestone, New York ("New Whitestone"), a newly chartered Federal savings association, has been organized to take over the assets and liabilities of Old Whitestone. The RTC has been appointed the conservator of New Whitestone.

New Whitestone has agreed to accept presentment of cash items payable by, through, or at Old Whitestone and to accept the return of cash items originally deposited at Old Whitestone. New Whitestone will use the routing number previously used by Old Whitestone (2214-7263-7).

Nassau Federal Savings and Loan Association

We have also been advised that effective March 16, 1990, the Director of the Office of Thrift Supervision, Department of the Treasury, determined that a ground for the appointment of a receiver existed for Nassau Federal Savings and Loan Association, Brooklyn, New York ("Old Nassau"). The RTC was appointed receiver for the purpose of liquidation. Nassau Savings and Loan Association, F.A., Brooklyn, New York ("New Nassau"), a newly chartered Federal savings association, has been organized to take over the assets and liabilities of Old Nassau. The RTC has been appointed the conservator of New Nassau.

New Nassau has agreed to accept presentment of cash items payable by, through, or at Old Nassau and to accept the return of cash items originally deposited at Old Nassau. New Nassau will use the routing number previously used by Old Nassau (2260-7238-8).
