**Extension of Comment Period on
Proposed Expansion of International Activities**

*To All Depository Institutions, and Others
Concerned, in the Second Federal Reserve District:*

Our Circular No. 10373, dated August 24, 1990, contained proposals by the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System that would permit U.S. banking organizations to extend the scope of their international activities. Comment on the proposals was originally requested by September 30.

In response to a number of requests for additional time to submit views on the issues involved, the Board of Governors has extended the deadline for comments to *October 14*.

Comments may be submitted by that date to the Board, as indicated in the notice sent to you with Circular No. 10373, or to our Banking Applications Department.
