**Resumption of Normal Check Services in New Jersey  
and the New York Metropolitan Area**

*To all Depository Institutions, and Others Concerned,  
in the Second Federal Reserve District:*

On January 8, 1996 this Bank notified all depository institutions and others concerned that due to the severe weather conditions caused by the blizzard of January 7-8, 1996 and the resulting emergency conditions then prevalent throughout New Jersey and the New York Metropolitan Area, the Bank was deferring credit for items drawn on, or cash items returned to, depository institutions in the affected areas until such time as the emergency conditions abated.

In the aftermath of the storm, conditions have continually improved. Effective Tuesday, January 9, 1996 at 6:00 p.m., the Bank is no longer deferring credit for items drawn on, or cash items returned to, depository institutions having routing numbers with 0212, 2212, 0210, 0260, 2260, 0214, 0219, 2214, 2219, 0215, 2215, 0216, or 2216 prefixes.
