New Counterfeit \$10 Federal Reserve Note

*To all Banks, Trust Companies and Savings Banks  
in the Second Federal Reserve District :*

The Treasury Department in its circular letter No. 500 describes a new counterfeit \$10 Federal Reserve note as follows:

“On the Federal Reserve Bank of Chicago; check letter ‘D’; series of 1914; D. F. Houston, Secretary of the Treasury; John Burke, Treasurer of the United States; portrait of Jackson.

“The number of the specimen at hand is G239608A. The workmanship on this note is so crude throughout that further description is deemed unnecessary.”
