STATEMENT FOR THE PRESS

The Federal Reserve Board today announced the election of the following directors of the Baltimore Branch of the Federal Reserve Bank of Richmond:

By the Board:

Mr. William Ingle, President, Baltimore Trust Co., and formerly Federal Reserve Agent at Richmond, Baltimore; and

Mr. Waldo Newcomer, President, National Exchange Bank, Baltimore.

By the Bank:

Mr. Morton M. Prentis, now in the employ of the Bank, who will be manager of the Branch. Under the regulations of the Federal Reserve Board, the Manager of the Branch is also a Director.

Col. H. B. Wilcox, Vice President of the Merchants-Mechanics First National Bank of Baltimore, who is also a director of the Federal Reserve Bank of Richmond.

Mr. Chas. C. Homer, President, Second National Bank of Baltimore and also President of the Baltimore Clearing House Association.

Mr. Prentis, who will be Manager of the Branch, has been with the Federal Reserve Bank of Richmond in the capacity of Manager of the Liberty Loan since last September. He was born in St. Louis, Mo., and held a position with the Third National Bank of that city for two years. He was with the National Bank of Commerce of Norfolk, Va. for nine years. From 1915 and prior to ~~this~~ employment by the Federal Reserve Bank, he was with the Treasury Department as a National Bank Examiner for this District, under the Comptroller of the Currency.
