Dear Sir:

Under separate cover we are forwarding to your bank, 100 copies of Form X-938 for use in making weekly reports to the Board of Federal Reserve Bank note issues. Weekly telegraphic data are desired only for items 2 and 8 showing Federal Reserve Bank notes by denominations received during the week covered by the report and on hand at close of business each Friday. In case no Federal Reserve bank notes are received during any week, it is requested that the weekly telegram contain the words "TUFT none" without mentioning any other code words against item 2. Data against item 8 should be wired each week, regardless of whether or not any changes are shown.

May I also request that the first report be submitted to the Board on the Friday following the receipt of the first shipment of Federal Reserve bank notes made to your bank.
