SUBJECT: SHIPMENTS OF CURRENCY TO AND
FROM RESERVE BANKS.

Dear Sir:

In order that the Board may be kept advised regarding currency movements to and from the Federal Reserve Bank, a form has been prepared for the use of the Reserve Banks in submitting reports to the Board showing these movements with respect to banks in Federal Reserve and Federal Reserve branch cities and banks outside these cities.

In case the information is available it is requested that the first report cover the month of October and be submitted as at close of business October 31. In case sufficient data covering the month of October are not available the first report may be submitted as at close of business November 30.
