of State bank and Trust  
company members.

Dear Sir:-

There are being forwarded to you today under separate cover copies of the December 18, 1919 edition of form 105, Condition report of State bank and Trust company members. It is requested that three copies of the form be sent to each non-national member bank in your district, with instructions to hold the blank forms pending receipt of a call for condition report, when they should be promptly filled out and two copies mailed to you -- in no case later than ten days after receipt of the call.

As no changes have been made in the form, the instructions issued by the Board on June 14, 1919, supplemented by those contained in our letter St.692 dated November 6, still apply and should be carefully followed. We are enclosing copies of the circular instructions with the forms 105, for use of banks which have joined the System since November 17th.
