SUBJECT: Governors' Conference.

Dear Sir:

The Board requests the Governors of the Federal Reserve Banks to meet in its Assembly Room in the Metropolitan Bank Building in Washington on the morning of Tuesday, April 12th, for a conference with the Federal Reserve Board.

A list of subjects which the Board desires to discuss with the Governors will be transmitted to each Governor in due course. Matters which relate more particularly to routine and fiscal agency operations will be discussed separately at conferences in which the Board will not participate. Each Governor is invited to send to this office a list of any topics which he may wish to have discussed at the conference with the Federal Reserve Board, and to Mr. Benjamin Strong, Governor of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York, a list of the topics relating to routine and fiscal agency matters which he desires to have considered at the Governors' conference.

It is expected that the conferences can be concluded by the afternoon of Friday, April 15th. The Board will be pleased to make such hotel reservations as may be requested.
