Dear Sir:

With reference to the Board's letter St. 1642 dated December 11, there are being forwarded to you today under separate cover copies each of forms 170 and 170a (superseding mimeograph forms 50 and 50a) for use in rendering monthly reports of clearing operations, and of changes in membership and in the number of non-member banks on the par list.

The first report on form 170 should cover the period from January 1 to 15, 1921, while subsequent reports should cover the monthly periods ending on the 15th of the respective months. The first report on form 170a should cover the monthly period ending on January 15, 1921.
