Dear Sir:

The Board has designated Tuesday, October 25th, as the opening date for the annual joint conference of Federal Reserve Agents and Governors of Federal Reserve Banks. It is the Board's desire that this conference be conducted in the same manner as last year and that both joint and separate sessions be held. It is suggested that the presiding officer of each body be constituted a committee of one to arrange a list of topics for separate discussion and that they act together in arranging the program for the joint meeting. The Board in due course will prepare a list of topics which it desires to have considered and it is hoped that the program can be completed and a copy placed in the hands of each Federal Reserve Agent and Governor not later than October 15th.
