SUBJECT: Record of Rotary Registry Lock Keys held by Federal Reserve Banks and Branches.

Dear Sir:

Recently one of the Branch Federal Reserve Banks reported to the Post Office Department the loss of a rotary registry lock key. Investigation of the matter was made by the proper postal authorities and the Post Office Inspector reported that there was no record kept by the Branch Bank of the numbers of the keys in its custody and that the keys were not safe-guarded in a satisfactory manner to prevent possibility of their being lost, stelen or put to an improper use.

This matter is being brought to the attention of all Governors and Federal Reserve Agents in order that the rotary registry lock keys furnished the Federal Reserve Banks and Branch Federal Reserve Banks may be properly safe-guarded.
