- 1. U. S. GOVERNMENT COUPONS Number of pieces and amount paid.
- 2. U. S. CERTIFICATES OF INDEBTEDNESS Number of pieces and amount redeemed or paid.
- 3. U. S. LIBERTY BONDS AND VICTORY NOTES Exchanges, conversions, etc., showing (a) number of pieces received, (b) number of pieces delivered, and (c) amount delivered, classified as follows:
