A week or ten days ago the Board sent to all Federal reserve banks a copy of the bill of complaint brought by the Pascagoula National Bank, of Mosspoint, Mississippi, against the Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta, et al., in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia.

Governor Harding of the Federal Reserve Bank of Boston has since sent to the Board a memorandum presenting an analytical discussion of the complaint which the Board believes will be of interest to you and to the Legal Department of your bank. Two copies of the memorandum in question are enclosed herewith.
