Series TS 1925.

Dear Sir:

The Board's letter of July 10, 1924 (X-4139) designated certain code words to be used in connection with wire transfers of Treasury Notes and Certificates of Indebtedness. As the Treasury Department is now offering a new series of Treasury Certificates of Indebtedness, dated September 15, 1924, Series TS 1925, the code word "BEFOUL" has been designated for use in connection with transactions in this new series. The word should be inserted in the Federal Reserve Telegraphic Code book following the supplemental code word "BEFOREHAND", on Page 24.
