In determining whether or not a given individual should be listed as an officer or an an employee the Board's letter X-3532 of October 5, 1922 should be used as a guide. After the statement has been completed it should be compared with data published on pages 249-252 of the Board's 1923 annual report, so that any differences may be reconciled before the report is transmitted to the Board.
