Dear Sir:

For use in the forthcoming annual report of the Federal Reserve Board covering operations during the calendar year 1924, it is requested that as soon after January 1, 1925, as practicable, you furnish the Board with a statement relating to the personnel of your bank (including branches, if any) as at close of business on December 31, 1923 and 1924, made out in accordance with the form attached hereto. The statement should not take account of changes in either the number or salaries of officers or employees that are to be made on January 1, 1925. In determining whether or not a given individual should be listed as an officer or an an employee the Board's letter X-3532 of October 5, 1922 should be used as a guide. After the statement has been completed it should be compared with data published on pages 249-252 of the Board's 1923 annual report, so that any differences may be reconciled before the report is transmitted to the Board.
