Dear Sir:

There is enclosed herewith a copy of a statement rendered to the Federal Reserve Board by Honorable Newton D. Baker in the sum of \$1,000 covering his professional services in connection with the Catlettsburg par clearance cases. The Board has considered and approved this statement, and has requested the Federal Reserve Bank of Cleveland to remit the amount to Mr. Baker direct.

Inasmuch as this case heretofore has been considered a System matter, the Board has directed that this fee be pro-rated among all Federal Reserve Banks. It is requested, therefore, that you remit direct to the Federal Reserve Bank of Cleveland the sum of \$83.33 as your proportionate share of the total fee.
