Subject: Holidays during November, 1925.

Dear Sir:

On Tuesday, November 3rd, the following Federal Reserve Banks and Branches will be closed account Election Day in their respective States: New York, Buffalo, Philadelphia, Pittsburgh, Richmond and Detroit.

Please include credits of November 3rd for New York, Philadelphia, Richmond and Detroit in your Gold Fund Clearing of the following day and make no shipments of Federal Reserve notes, fit or unfit, on that date, for account of the Head Offices mentioned.

On Wednesday, November 11th, Armistice Day, there will be no Gold Fund or Federal Reserve Note Clearing and the books of the Board will be closed. For your information, the offices of the Board and the following Banks and Branches will be open for business as usual: Boston, New York, Buffalo, Cleveland, Cincinnati, Atlanta and Detroit.

On Thursday, November 26th, Thanksgiving Day, there will be no Gold Fund or Federal Reserve Note Clearing, and the books of the Board will be closed.
