The figures for December 31, 1924 and 1925 will be published in the Board's 1925 annual report, and accordingly should not take account of changes in either the number or salaries of officers or employees that are put into effect as of January 1. In determining whether or not a given individual should be listed as an officer or an employee the Board's letter X-3532 of October 5, 1922 should be used as a guide. After the statement has been completed it should be compared with data published on pages 217-220 of the Board's 1924 annual report, so that any differences may be reconciled before the report is transmitted to the Board.
