SUBJECT: Expenses of Special Counsel in Hugo Bank Case.

The enclosed statement in the amount of \$15,243.86 has been received from Hon. Newton D. Baker, covering professional services and expenses in connection with the case of Hugo State Bank v. Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis, in which the Supreme Court of Minnesota recently rendered a favorable opinion. This statement has been approved by the Federal Reserve Board and forwarded to the Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis for payment.
