SUBJECT: New Issues of Treasury Certificates of  
Indebtedness.

Dear Sir:

In connection with telegraphic transactions between Federal reserve banks covering Government securities, the following code words have been designated to cover new issues of Treasury Certificates of Indebtedness:

"NOWHOBEN" Treasury Certificates of Indebtedness, Series TAG-1933 - 4%, to be dated March 15, 1933, maturing August 15, 1933. (five months)

"NOWHOBEST" Treasury Certificates of Indebtedness, Series TD2-1933 - 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ %, to be dated March 15, 1933, maturing December 15, 1933. (nine months)

These code words should be inserted in the Federal reserve telegraph code book, following the supplemental code word "NOWHOBAD" on page 172.
