Proviso regarding payment of interest QUOTE in accordance with terms

of any certificate of deposit or other contract heretofore entered

into in good faith UNQUOTE which was in force on June 16, 1933, does not

authorize payment of interest until end of customary interest period unless

there was a definite contract to that effect. Member banks are forbidden

to renew or extend any such contract without eliminating provision for payment of interest and they are required to take such action as may be necessary to eliminate payment of interest on demand deposits as soon as possible consistently with their contractual obligations.
