SUBJECT: Revision of Form 194.

Dear Sir:

Under separate cover there is being forwarded a supply of Form 194, which has recently been revised. It will be noted that this form, which should be used in submitting reports beginning with the month of May, 1933, calls for information as to the amount of gold certificates, by denominations, on hand at the end of the report month in addition to the data heretofore furnished in regard to Federal reserve notes. For the Board's records it is requested that a statement be submitted showing the amount of gold certificates, by denominations, on hand on the last day of the month from January to April, 1933, inclusive.

It is requested that the supply of the old Form 194 now on hand be used, with an appropriate amendment in the title, in reporting Federal reserve bank notes received, issued and on hand.
