effective July 24, in connection with requests to the Board for
shipment of Federal reserve bank notes and advice from the Board
that arrangements are being made for shipment of such notes:

CHINLACE Please request Comptroller of the Currency to
ship (Federal Reserve Agent, Assistant Federal
Reserve Agent, Bank or Branch) Federal reserve
bank notes as follows: (amount) (denomination).
Confirmation is being forwarded by mail.

CHINLARK Comptroller of the Currency is arranging with
the Bureau of Engraving & Printing for shipment
today to (Federal Reserve Agent, Assistant Fed-
eral Reserve Agent, Bank or Branch) of Federal
reserve bank notes as follows: (amount) (denomi-
nation).

These words should be inserted in the Federal reserve Telegraph
Code following the word CHINKIRK, on page 49.
