ADDRESS OFFICIAL CORRESPONDENCE TO THE FEDERAL RESERVE BOARD

SUBJECT: List of State Bank Members Published in Connection with Par List.

Dear Sir:

Beginning with the forthcoming July 1, 1933, issue of the Par List, it is proposed to limit the list of State bank members appearing at the end of the par list to those banks which have been licensed by the Secretary of the Treasury to conduct normal banking operations. The proof copy of the list of State bank membors has, therefore, been revised to exclude non-licensed banks, but before the revised list is published we should like to have it checked by the Federal reserve banks. Accordingly, a revised copy of that part of the proof of the July 1 par list which contains a list of the licensed State bank members in your district is inclosed, and it will be appreciated if you will check the list promptly and advise the Board not later than Wednesday morning, July 19, by telegraph if necessary, what changes, if any, should be made therein in order that it may agree with your records.
