SUBJECT: Code Words Covering New Issues of Treasury Bills.

Dear Sir:

In connection with tolegraphic transactions in Government securities between Federal reserve banks, the following code words have been designated to cover new issues of Treasury Bills:

"NOYMIS" - Treasury Bills to be dated May 20, 1936, and to mature December 15, 1936.

"NOYMUF" - Treasury Bills to be dated May 20, 1936, and to mature February 17, 1937.

These words should be inserted in the Federal Reserve Telegraph Code book, following the supplemental code word "NOYMEA" on page 172.
