Issue of Treasury Bonds.




Dear Sir:

In connection with telegraphic transactions between Federal reserve banks covering Government securities, the following code word has been designated to cover a new issue of Treasury Bonds:

"NOWCOSY" - 2 3/4% Treasury Bonds of 1956-59, to be dated September 15, 1936, and to mature September 15, 1959.

This code word should be inserted in the Federal Reserve Telegraph Code book, on page 172.
