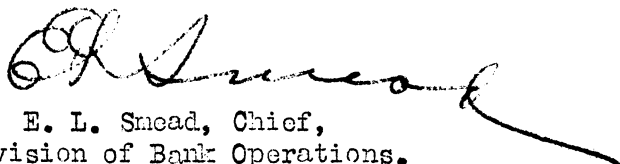
Dear Sir:

160	Monthly report of receipts and payments of paper currency.
E	Semiannual functional expense report.
