INTERPRETATION OF LAW OR REGULATION

October 6, 1941

<u>W-89</u>. The classification "water heaters designed for household use" includes all water heaters with a storage tank capacity of 85 gallons or less.

October 8, 1941

<u>W-90</u>. The classification "cooking stoves and ranges with less than seven heating surfaces" does not include cooking and baking equipment that is clearly designed for commercial use and not suitable for use in households, even though having less than seven heating surfaces. A cooking stove or range or oven, which is designed for commercial use in restaurants and hetels, and which has a single or continuous heating surface or heating unit, is not included. A deep-fat fryer designed for such use is not included.

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
