Dear Sir:

On Saturday, May 30, Memorial Day, the offices of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System will be closed and there will be neither transit nor Federal Reserve note clearing through the Board's Interdistrict Settlement Fund. All Federal Reserve Banks and branches will be closed on that day except Atlanta, Birmingham, Jacksonville, Little Rock, and Louisville.
