The tables on page 4 to 27 furnish a complete record of the transactions on the New York Stock Exchange during September and the range since Jan. 1. They need no extended introduction, as they are self-explanatory. The tables embrace every security dealt in on the Exchange. We give bonds first, using the classification adopted in the official list. The italic letters in the column headed "Interest Period" indicate in each case the month when the bonds mature.

All quotations for interest-paying bonds are at a price to which accrued interest must be added. The exceptions to the rule are income bonds and bonds on which interest is in default. This method of quoting bonds became effective Jan. 2, 1909. Quotations after decimal point represent one or more 32nds of a point.
