REVIEW OF APRIL.

In American railroad history, April 1898 will stand as an eventful month, marking the outbreak of hostilities between the United States and Spain. The event operated greatly to depress business, but in the markets there was a complete absence of panicky incidents, such as frequently attend the beginning of armed conflicts between nations. One prominent reason for this no doubt was the strength of our foreign trade position, which gave us command of large amounts of gold and thus furnished assurance against a derangement of our finances. Then also a conflict had for some time seemed probable, and preparations been made for it, so that its occurrence was in a measure discounted. To this must also be added the feeling, widely entertained, that owing to the disparity in the strength of the two combatants the outcome could in no circumstances be doubtful, and that the struggle would be of short duration.

At the beginning of the month all hope of a peaceful termination had not yet been abandoned. Spain's reply to the final proposition of the United States was received on the night of the 13th of March. It was considered unsatisfactory and with it the President's diplomatic efforts came to an end. A message from the President to Congress was expected on Monday the 6th and again on Wednesday the 6th. Then it was announced that it had been decided to defer sending it in until the following Monday in order to give General Lee time to get Americans out of Cuba and to get out himself, the Government having decided to recall all the American consuls in the island. The delay was thought to hold out one more chance of an amicable settlement, especially as the Pope and the great European Powers were seeking to persuade Spain

to accede to the demands of the United States. Yielding to these solicitations, Spain on April 9 agreed to withdraw Gen. Blanco to declare an armistice in Cuba. Had the action been taken earlier, it might have altered the whole situation. As it was, it came too late. On Monday the 13th (Gen. Lee having in the meantime left Havana, and landed in the United States, where he was the recipient of noteworthy demonstrations of popular approval), the President sent his message to Congress, urging intervention (but without recognition of the Cuban insurgents), and asking for authority to use the army and navy for this purpose.

On Wednesday the 15th the House of Representatives, by a vote of 224 to 19, passed resolutions closely according with the President's suggestions. The Senate on the night of Saturday the 16th, by a vote of 67 to 12, substituted its own resolutions, which were vigorous in form—"demanding that the Government of Spain relinquish its authority and government in the island of Cuba," declaring that the Cuban people "are and of right ought to be free and independent," besides recognizing the Cuban insurgents. Repeated conferences were necessary to reconcile the differences between the two branches. The House insisted on striking out the words "are and" given in italics above, and also the reference to the recognition of the insurgents, but finally yielded the first point when the Senate conferees reached on the question of recognition. In their amended form the resolutions were passed at 1:30 o'clock in the morning of the 20th in the Senate by a vote of 42 to 35, while in the House they were passed at about 2:00 o'clock A. M. by a vote of 323 to 6.

President McKinley signed the resolutions in the morning of the 20th. Senor Luis Polo y Bernabe, the Spanish Minister at Washington, was immediately notified that an ultimatum in accordance with the terms of the resolution had been forwarded to U. S. Minister Woodford at Madrid for transmission to the Spanish Government. Senor Polo in reply asked for his passports. At Madrid the Spanish Government notified Minister Woodford the next day (before he had a chance to present the ultimatum) that diplomatic negotiations between the two countries were broken off, and he accordingly asked for his passports. On the 22d the American fleet off Key West began capturing Spanish ships, taking as a first prize the merchantman Buena Ventura; subsequently many more ships were

captured, among others the Catalina and the Panama. On the 22d also the President issued his proclamation declaring a blockade "of the north coast of Cuba, including ports on said coast between Cardenas and Bahia Honda and the port of Cienfuegos, on the south coast of Cuba;" the North Atlantic squadron, under Rear-Admiral (then Captain) Sampson, had the same morning been sent to enforce the blockade. On the 23d the President called for 125,000 volunteers, in accordance with an Act of Congress approved by him the day before. These volunteers were subsequently selected from the militia regiments of the several States. On the 26th the Hull bill for the reorganization of the regular army in time of war became a law.

The ultimatum to Spain allowed until noon of Saturday April 23 for an answer, but, as we have seen, hostilities actually began before that date. On the 25th Congress formally declared that war existed and had existed since and including April 21. Spain having previously (April 24) granted United States ships anchored in Spanish harbors 30 days to take their departure, President McKinley, by proclamation April 26, granted to Spanish ships the same right, giving them until May 21 to load and depart. The latter part of the month the United States squadron in Asiatic waters under Commodore Dewey was ordered to the Philippine Islands, and the beginning of May achieved a brilliant victory over the the Spanish fleet and forts. In Cuban waters the forts at Matanzas were bombarded on the 27th by a portion of Admiral Sampson's squadron, and subsequently there was some desultory firing at minor points. The House of Representatives on the 29th passed the War Revenue Bill reported by Chairman Dingley of the Committee of Ways and Means, providing for extra internal revenue taxes calculated to yield 100 million dollars additional revenue and also authorizing the issue, if needed, of 500 millions bonds and 100 million certificates. On the 27th Secretary of the Treasury Gage had an informal conference with New York bankers with reference to the possibility of an issue of bonds. The war necessarily had an effect in hampering commerce; as one instance may be mentioned the adoption of new harbor rules at New York, Boston and other points, forbidding the entrance of vessels between sunset and sunrise. The United States made announcement that it would not resort to privateering, but Spain reserve the right under certain limitations. An act was signed by the President on the 22d prohibiting the exportation of coal and war supplies without the permission of the Government.

Among the incidents of the month was the forced resignation on the 25th of Secretary of State John Sherman, he being incapacitated for arduous duties by reason of failing powers and old age. He was succeeded by the Assistant Secretary, Judge William R. Day. Postmaster-General James A. Gary resigned on the 21st because of ill health. Charles Emory Smith became his successor. Several of the States followed New York's lead of the previous month, and voted extra appropriations for their national guards—Ohio, \$1,000,000; Massachusetts, Michigan and Iowa, each \$500,000; Rhode Island, \$150,000.

The price of wheat sharply advanced on the outbreak of war. On the 25th and 26th alone the rise amounted to 14 cents a bushel. The May option, both here and in Chicago, sold up to \$1.25. U. S. Govern-

ment coupon 4s of 1925 sold at 119½ April 30, against 122½ March 31; on the 19th the price was 117½.

In the money market the war had no seriously disturbing influence. While time loans were firm and higher in view of the uncertainties of the future, call loans tended downward. The call for money from the interior was heavy, but was offset by the gold imports.

The foreign exchange market was weak until the latter part of the month, the advance in the Bank of England rate on the 7th (to 4 per cent) tending to widen the difference between long sterling, and short and cable transfers; imports of gold continued large. On the 22d a sharp upward movement began which lasted until near the end of the month and gold engagements then fell off.

In the stock market the effect of the outbreak of war was to produce a condition of stagnation rather than to precipitate any serious break in prices. The Stock Exchange, on account of the critical nature of the Spanish-American situation, was kept open on Good Friday, April 8th, but, as it happened, transactions were insignificant. There was a sharp recovery towards the close of the month on reports of successful exploits by our navy.
