Unless otherwise noted, the tables referred to in the Federal Reserve Bulletin are published each month, and they contain the latest annual, quarterly, monthly, or weekly data available as of the date of publication. Changes in the form or content of tables during 1980 have been noted.

Because the frequency of the data shown may vary among the three publications listed, the frequencies for each table are shown in parentheses, as are other pertinent differences.

Generally speaking, titles of tables in the <u>Annual Statistical Digest</u> do not indicate the period covered, and no attempt has been made to include such information unless the period is longer or shorter than the five-year span covered by the Digest for 1974-78 or the ten-year span for the Digest for 1970-79.

Because the sequence is established by the order of the <u>Bulletin</u> tables, the table numbers for the <u>Digests</u> are not necessarily consecutive.


