Official Appointment Announced at St. Louis Fed

St. Louis, Missouri, September 6, 1983 -- Theodore H. Roberts, president, Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis, today announced the promotion of Michael T. Moriarty to vice president of the Bank in St. Louis.

Moriarty, who until his promotion was assistant vice president and assistant manager of the Bank's Little Rock Branch, will have administrative responsibility for the Cash and Securities Departments.
