ST. LOUIS -- The Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis has announced the appointment of William T. Gavin to the position of assistant vice president and research editor, effective May 1, 1994. Gavin's primary responsibility is content editor for the Review, the Bank's bimonthly research publication.

Prior to his promotion, Gavin served as an assistant vice president and economist at the Federal Reserve Bank of Cleveland. Before joining the Cleveland Fed in 1980, he was an adjunct professor at Case Western Reserve University and Cleveland State University. Gavin holds a bachelor's degree from Xavier University, Cincinnati, Ohio, and a Ph.D. from Ohio State University.
