ST. LOUIS -- Thomas A. Boone was named vice president and assistant branch manager of the Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis' Louisville Branch, effective Sept. 1, 1995.

Boone began his career at the Louisville Branch in 1972 as a management trainee and has since worked in almost every area of the Branch. He was promoted to operations officer in 1990 and an assistant vice president in 1993. Boone has a bachelor's degree from Indiana University and attended the Graduate School of Banking in Madison, Wis.

The Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis has branches in Louisville, Memphis and Little Rock. It serves the Eighth Federal Reserve District which includes all of Arkansas, eastern Missouri, southern Indiana and Illinois, western Kentucky and Tennessee, and northern Mississippi.
