

NATIONAL ECONOMIC TRENDS

Total spending increased at an 11.4 percent annual rate from the first to the second quarter of 1972, according to recently revised data. The second quarter gain represents a continuation of the strong surge in spending which began in the second half of last year. Total spending advanced at a 10.5 percent rate from the third quarter of 1971 to the second quarter of 1972, after rising 7.2 percent in the preceding year. Real product growth over the three-quarter period just ended was at a 7.5 percent rate, compared with a 2.2 percent increase in the preceding year.

Total civilian employment, which increased at a 3.4 percent rate from December 1971 to July, rose at a faster pace than the civilian labor force, which increased at a 2.5 percent rate over the same period. These gains in employment relative to labor force growth fostered a drop in the unemployment rate from 6 percent in December 1971 to 5.5 percent in July. The unemployment rate of heads of households fell from 3.8 percent to 3.3 percent in the December 1971-July 1972 period, and the unemployment rate of teenagers fell from 17.3 percent to a 14.8 percent over the same period.

The rise in unit labor cost slowed in second quarter 1972 reflecting deceleration in compensation per man-hour and a sharp increase of productivity. Unit labor costs increased at a 1.8 percent rate from the third quarter of 1971 to the second quarter of 1972, compared with a 3.4 percent rise in the preceding year.

With the exception of wholesale prices of agricultural goods, most comprehensive price indexes have increased at a slower rate since late last summer. The implicit GNP price deflator increased at a 2.8 percent rate from the third quarter of 1971 to the second quarter of 1972, compared with a 4.9 percent rise in the preceding year. Consumer prices increased at a 2.9 percent rate from August 1971 to July, after rising 4.5 percent in the preceding year. Wholesale prices of industrial commodities advanced at a 2.8 percent rate in the August 1971-July 1972 period, compared with a 4.4 percent rise in the preceding twelve months. Wholesale prices of farm products and processed foods and feeds increased at a 7.2 percent rate from last August to July, after rising 3.1 percent in the preceding year.



INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION





RETAIL SALES











GENERAL PRICE INDEX*




