HB-499 has been passed and will take effect October 1, 1987. The law prohibits any lender from using or disclosing information relative to a contract of insurance required by the credit transaction for the purpose of replacing such insurance without the prior written consent of the borrower. If a bank owns an insurance agency, the bank may not disclose this information to its agency unless it first obtains the written consent of the borrower. This written consent can be obtained at the time the loan is made so banks may wish to revise their documents.
