AN addition of 10 per cent. upon the duty is levied on all Goods, Wares and Merchandise when imported in foreign vessels, (except British vessels from Great Britain, with goods, produce or manufactures of Britain only); and all articles subject to duty imported into the United States not having been landed more than one year, are allowed a drawback of the duties, except foreign dried and pickled fish, and other salt provisions, fish oil, or playing cards, subject to a deduction of 2 1/2 per cent except Spirits, which is 2 cents per gallon, upon the quantity, and 3 per cent. on the amount of the duties.

GOODS, wares and merchandise, not free and not subject to any other rate of duty, pay 15 per cent. ad valorem. The following articles are not mentioned in the Tariff and are supposed to come under this denomination, and consequently pay the above duty, namely: Anniseed, Books, Bricks and Tiles, Beeswax, Colours prepared either dry or ground in oil other than expressed in the tariff. Dates or dried fruit other than expressed in do., Medicinal Drugs of every description, Prings for upholsterers and coach makers. Gauze, Ginger race or powdered, Girandoles composed of various materials. Hairpowder, Honey, Lamp Black, Lime Juice, Manufactures of Linen other than expressed in the tariff, do. of Silk, do. do do., Malt, Marble wrought, Nankeens direct from China, Oranges, Lemons and Limes, Ointments, Pipes, Paintings, Pictures and Prints, Quicksilver, Starch, Slates, and Wool.

TONNAGE DUTY—On American vessels, 6 cents per ton—foreign vessels \$2.50, except British vessels from Great Britain, and all her possessions, other than her West India and North American colonies, which pay the same tonnage as other foreign vessels.

TARES ALLOWED AT THE CUSTOM-HOUSE.—On SUGAR, in boxes, 15 per cent; in casks, 12 per cent; and in bags or mats, 5 per cent.—COFFEE, in casks, 12, in bags 2, and in bales 3 per cent.—COTTON, in bales 2, and in casks 6 per cent.—COCOA, in casks 10, and in bags 1 per cent.—CHEESE, in boxes, 20 per cent—Peanut, in casks 12, in bales 5, and in bags two per cent.—PIMENTO, in bags, 3 per cent.—Leakage on spirits 2 per cent.
