Ratio to Total Population, 1880.

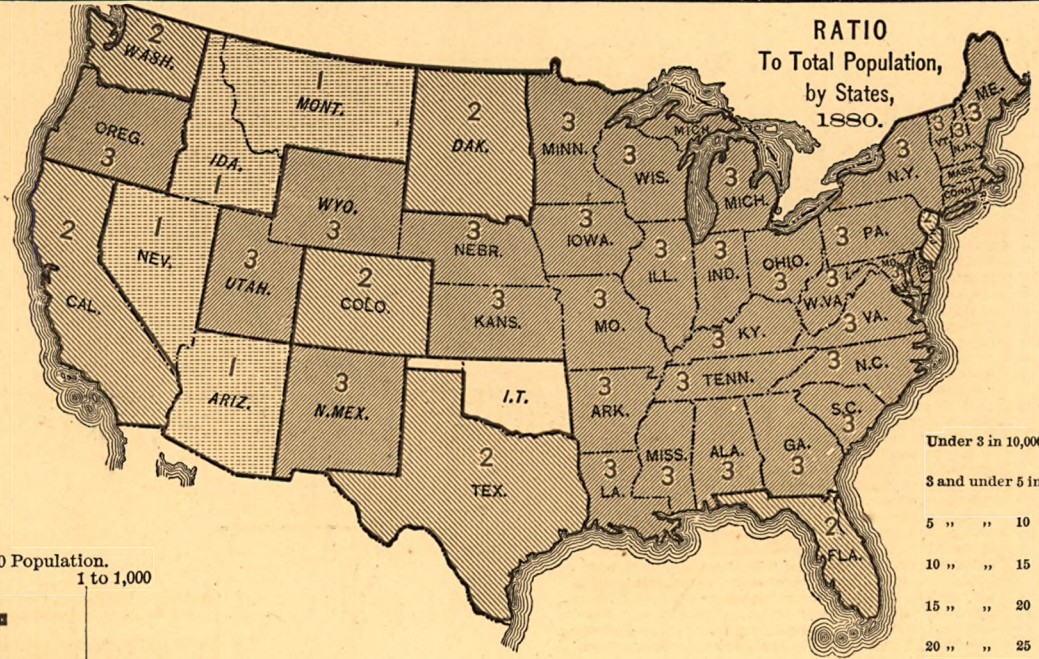

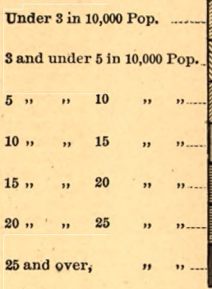

RATIO To Total Population, by States, 1880.



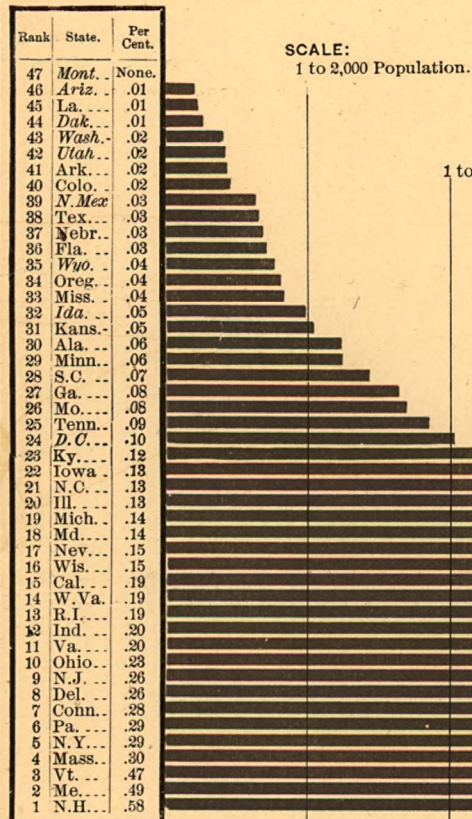

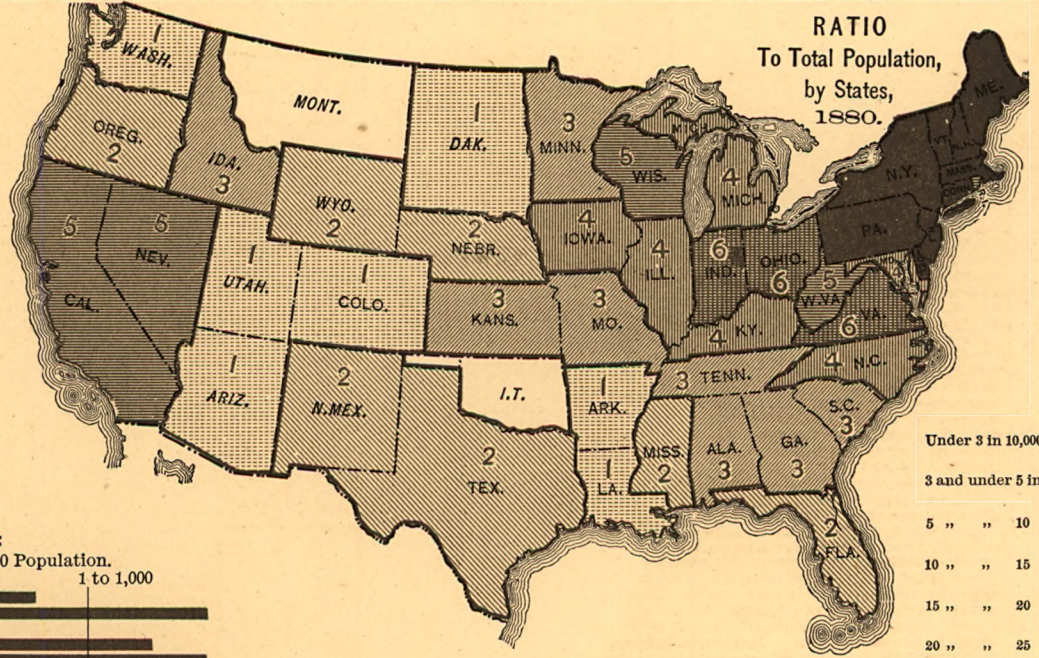

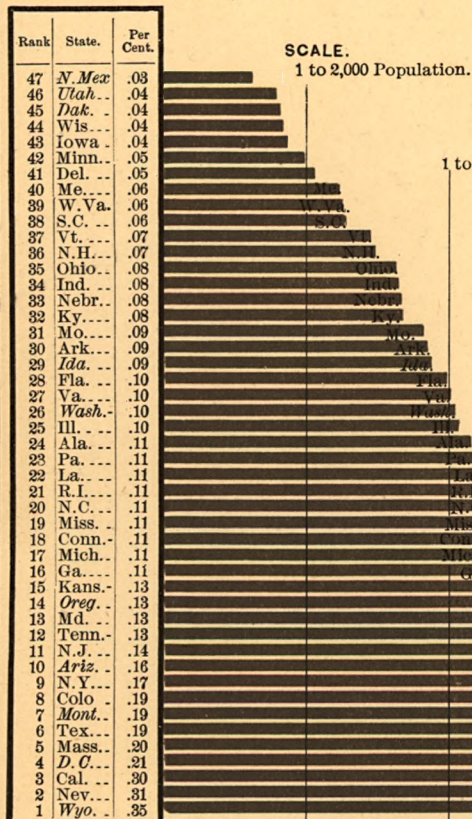

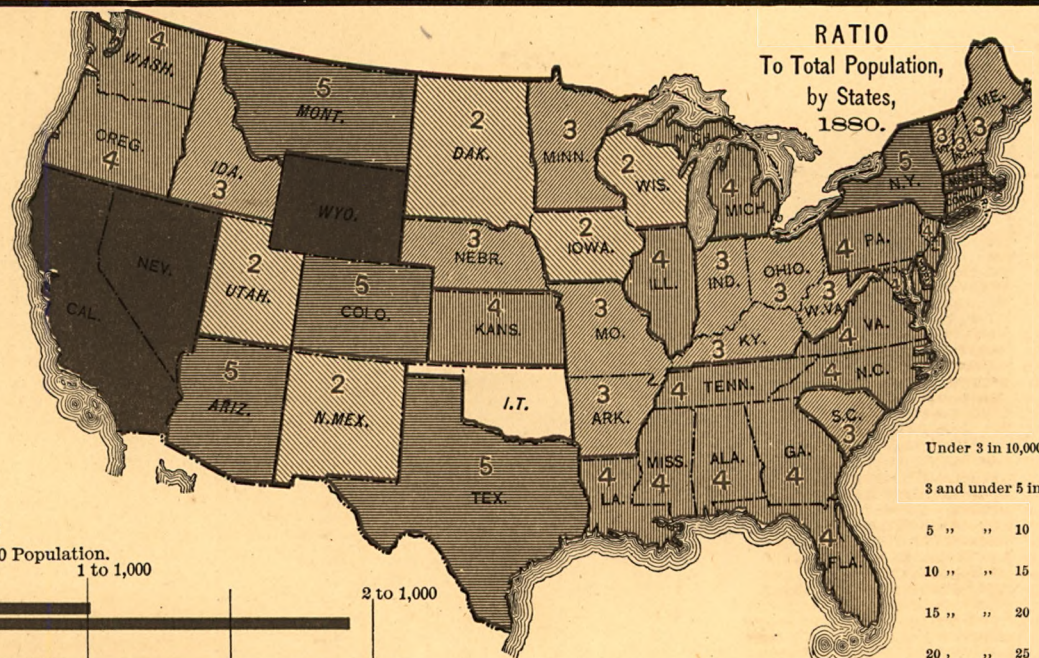
