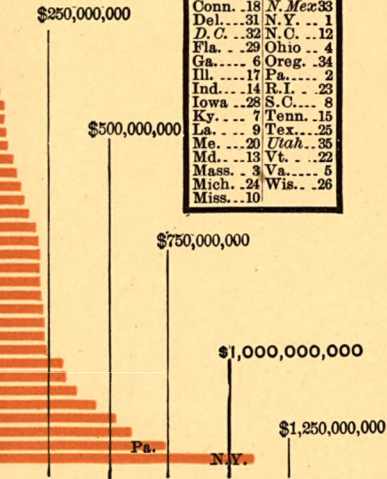

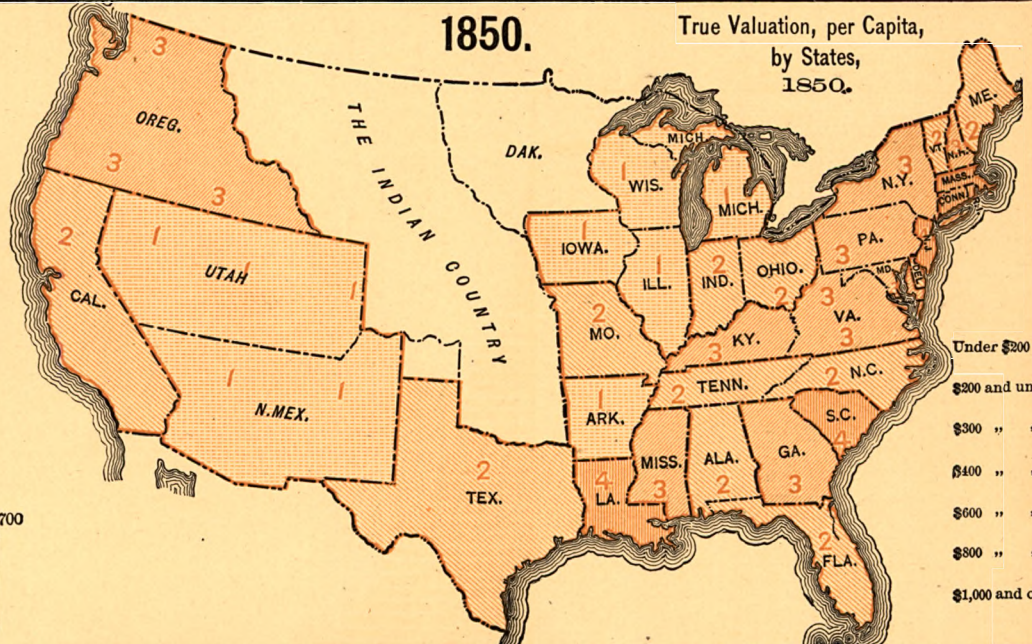

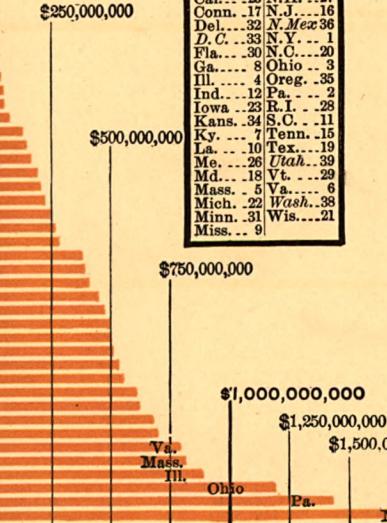

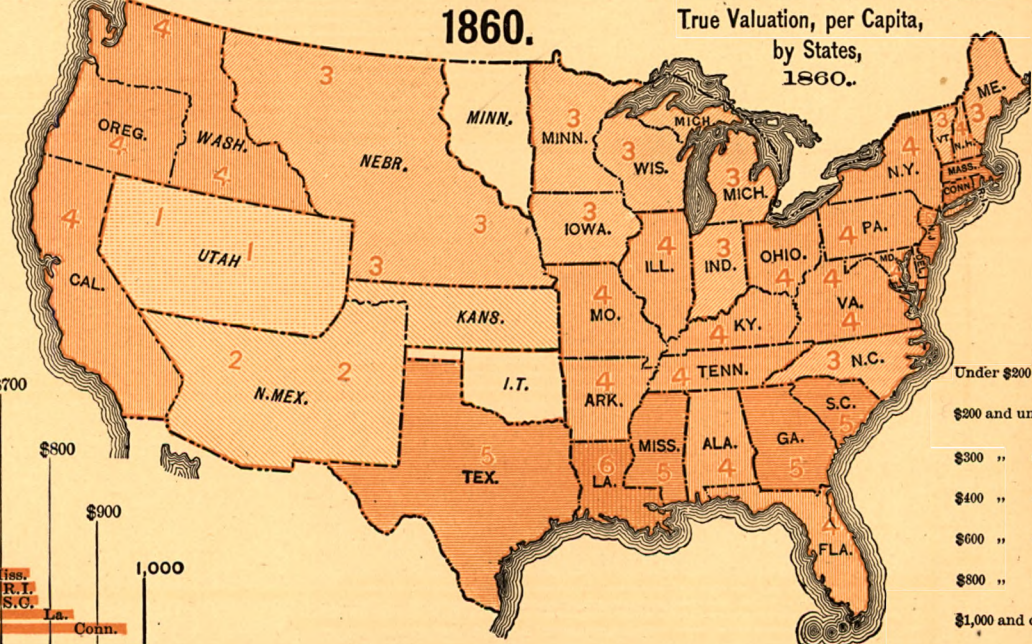

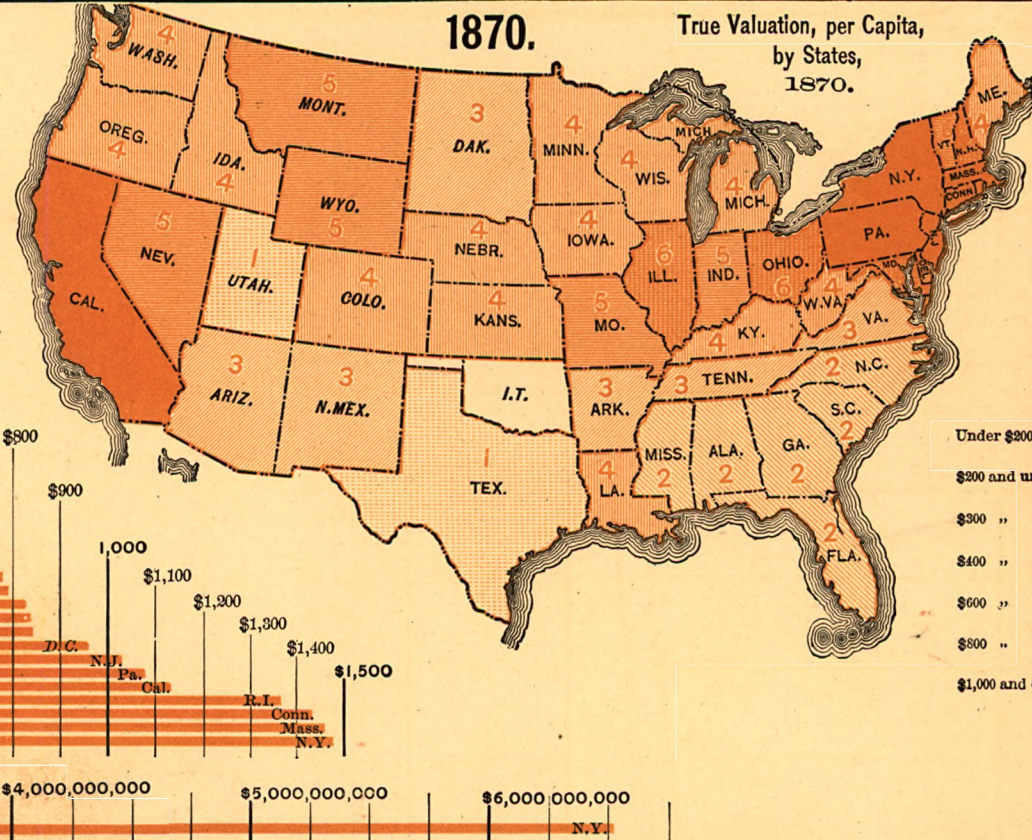

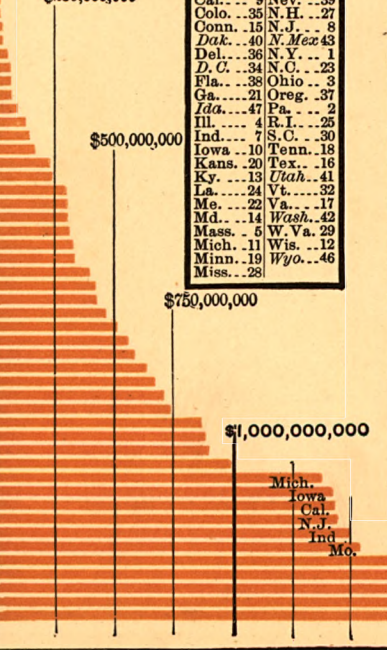

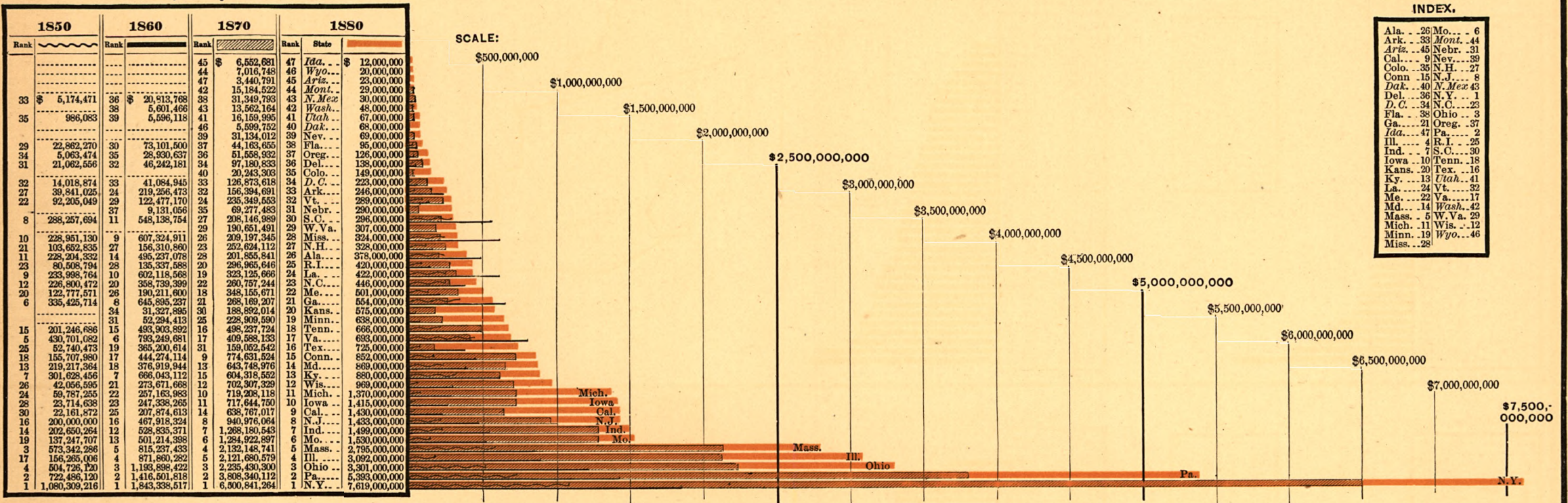

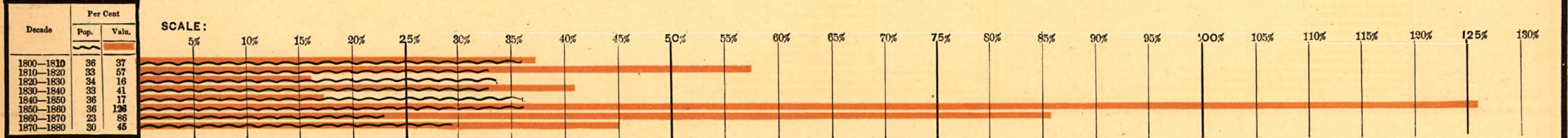

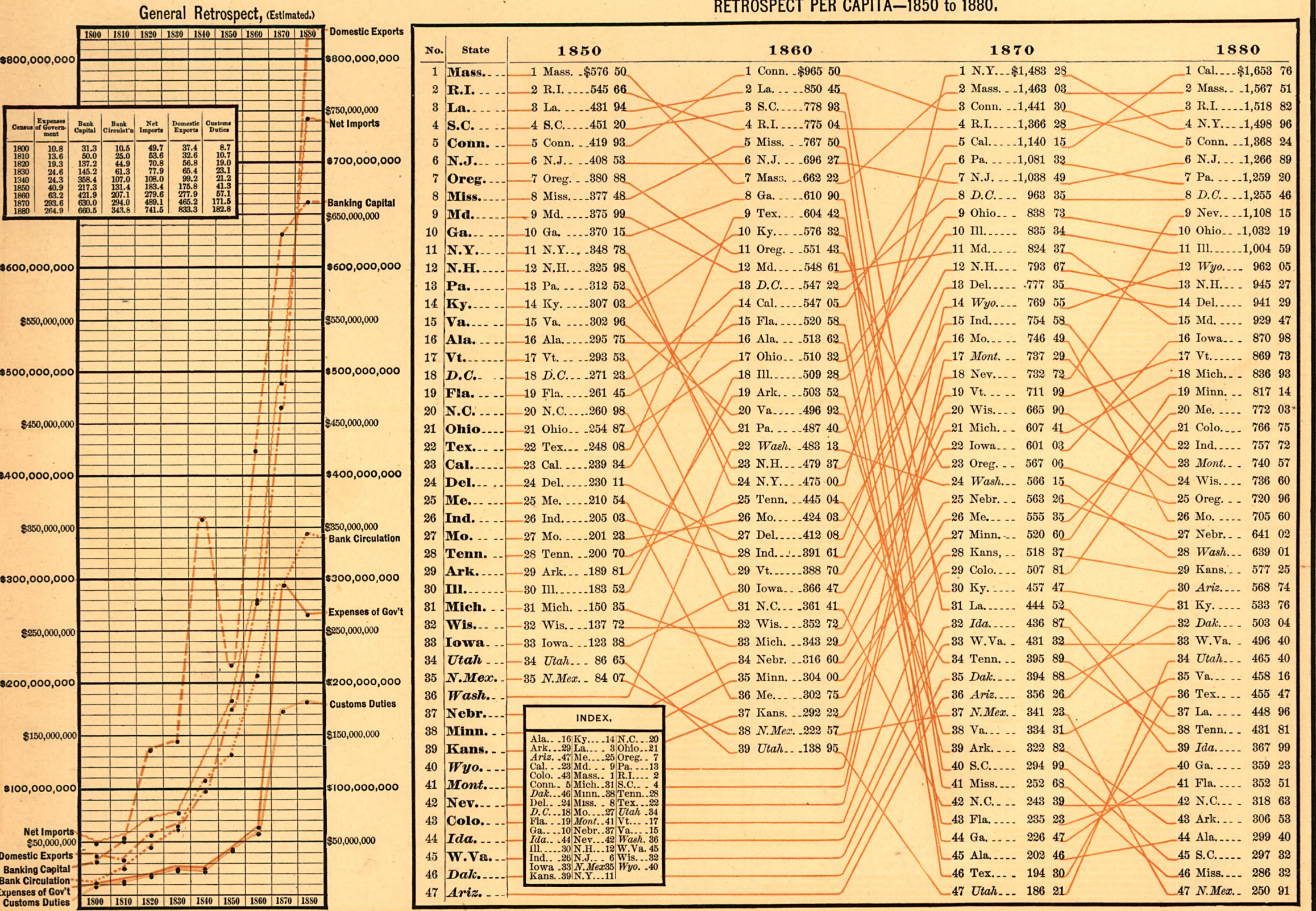
Retrospect by Aggregates, (Estimated.)

RETROSPECT PER CAPITA—1850 to 1880.



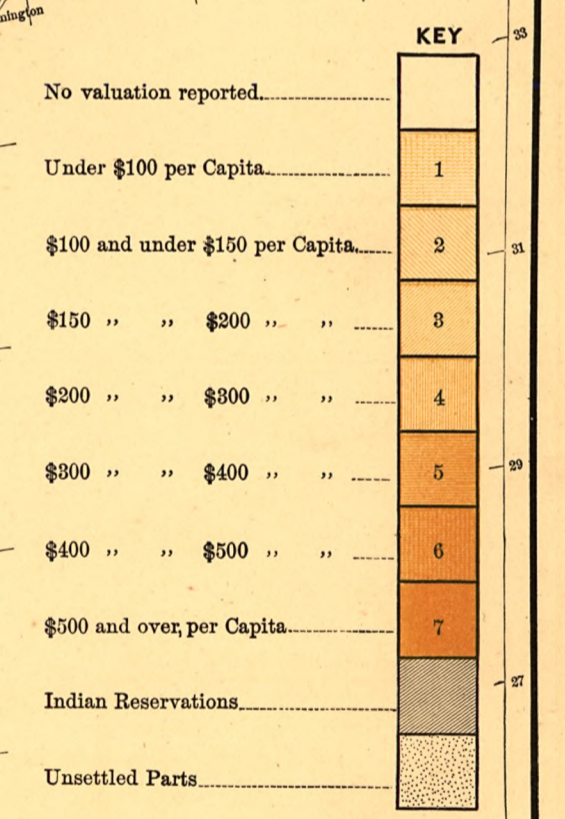
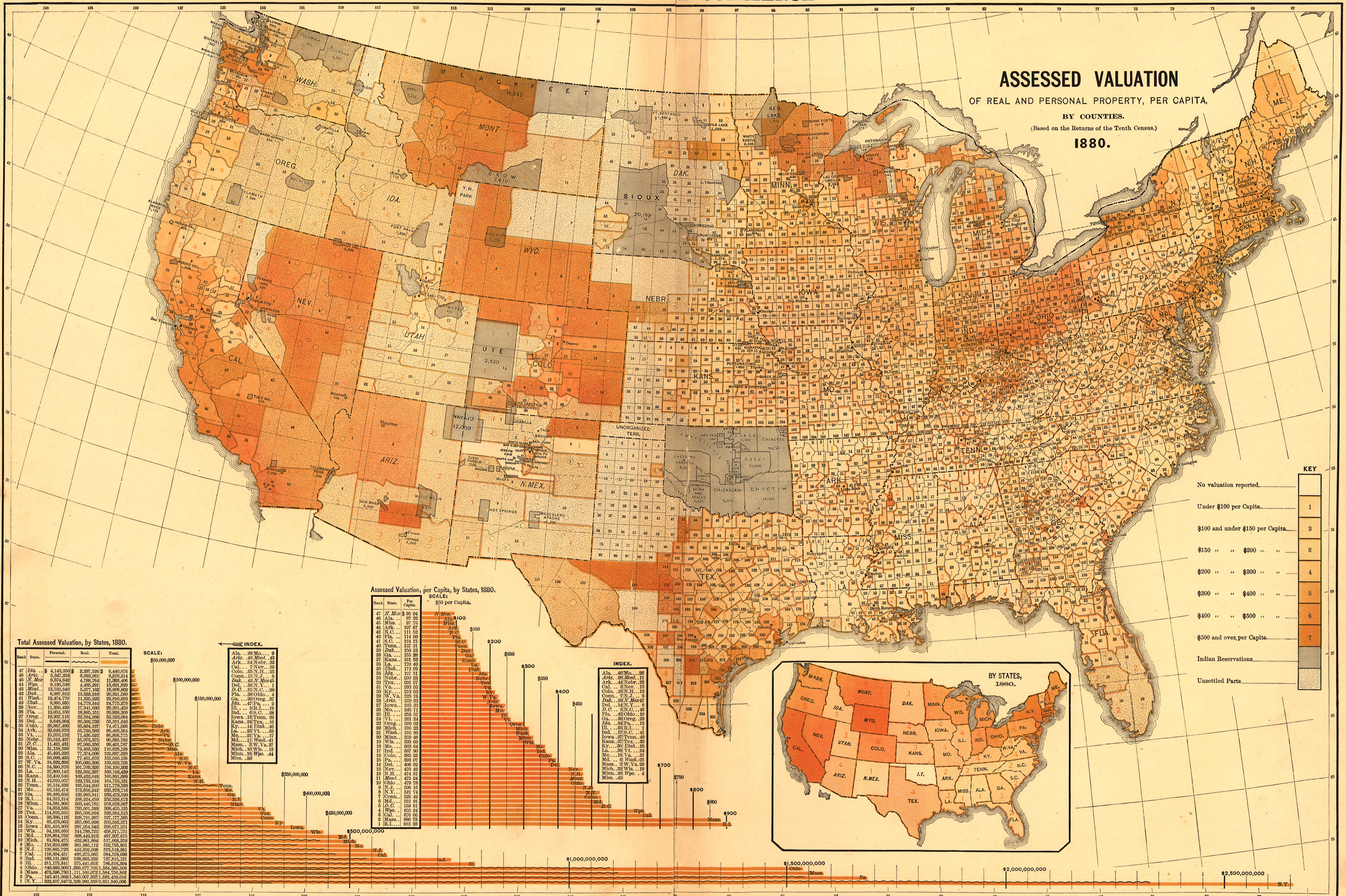

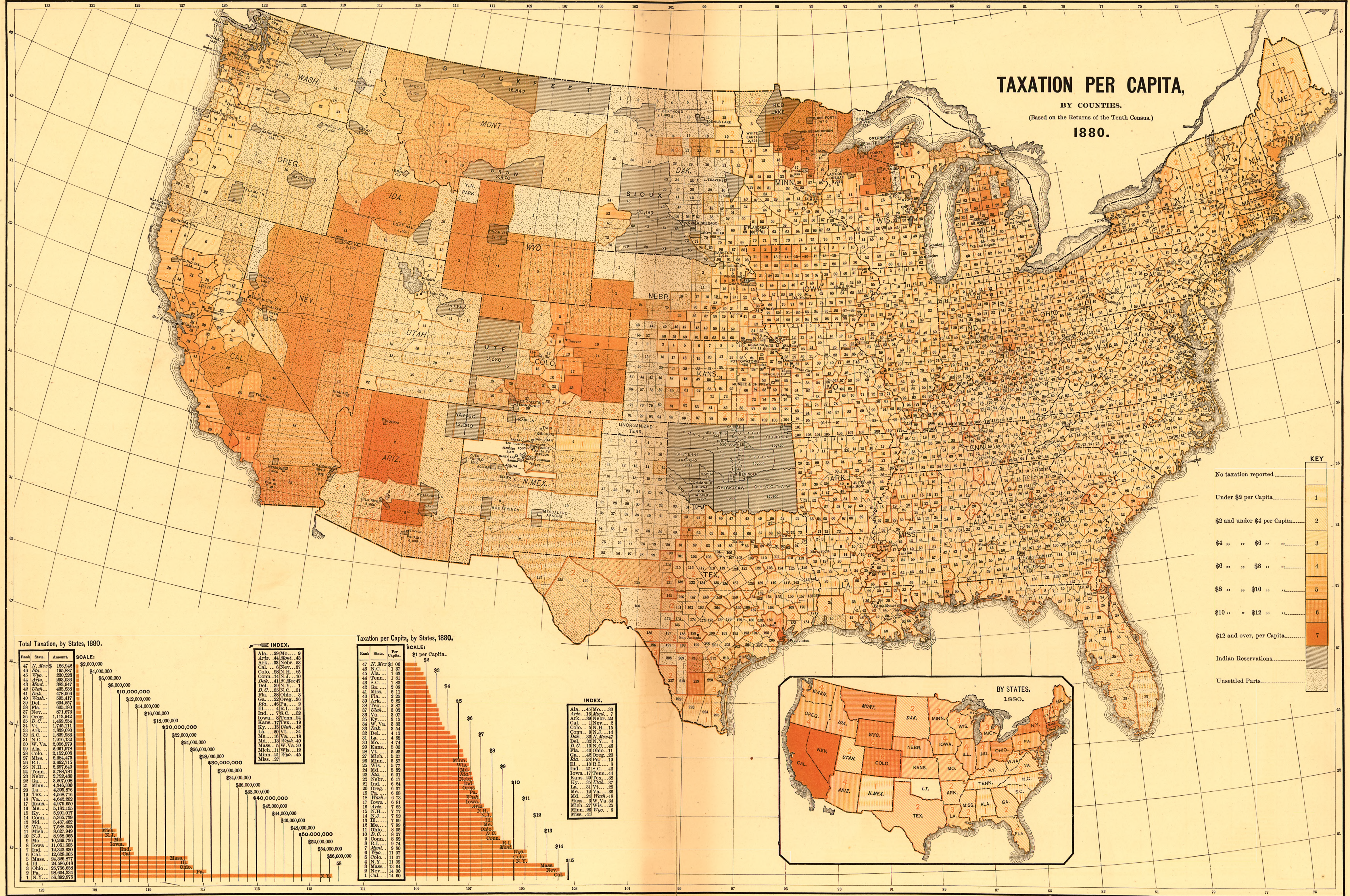

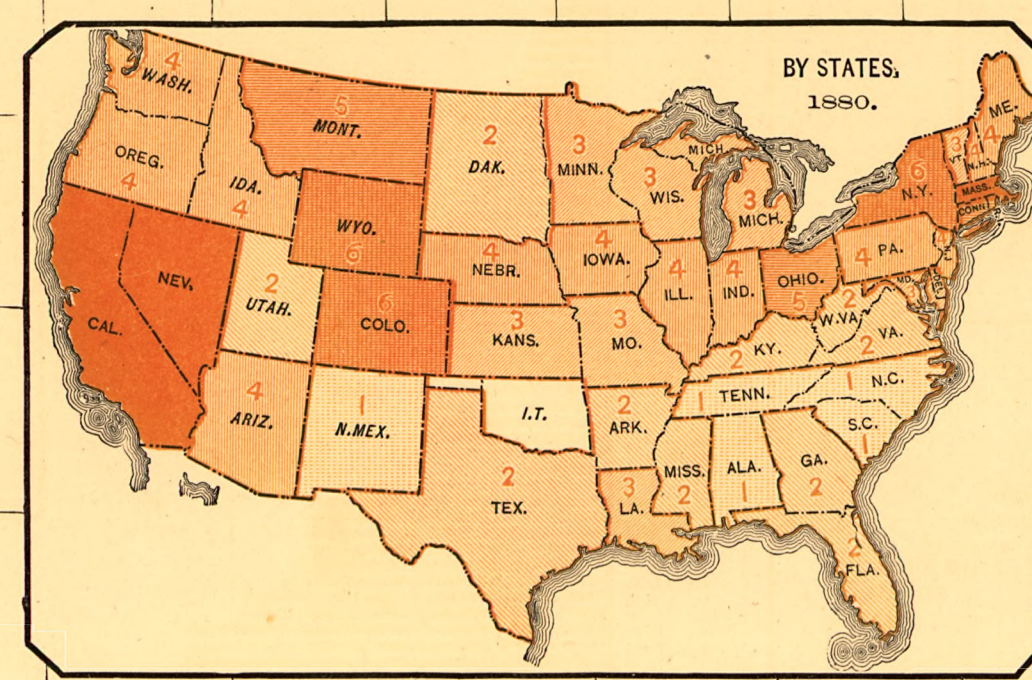


TAXATION PER CAPITA, BY COUNTIES. (Based on the Returns of the Tenth Census.) 1880.
