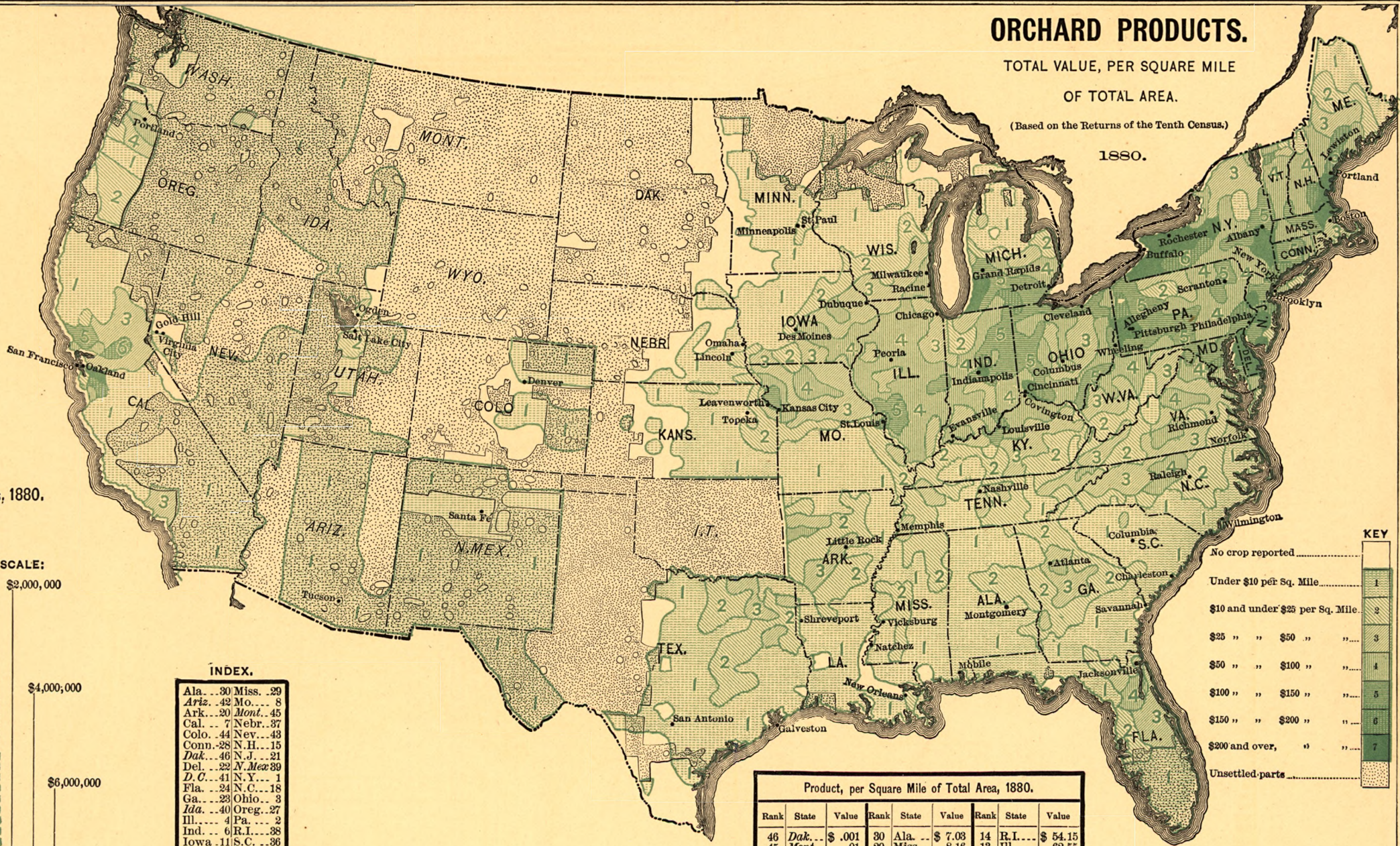

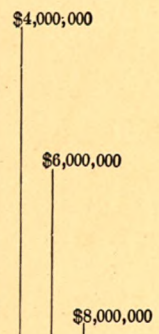

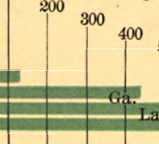

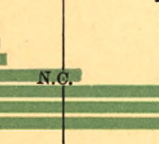

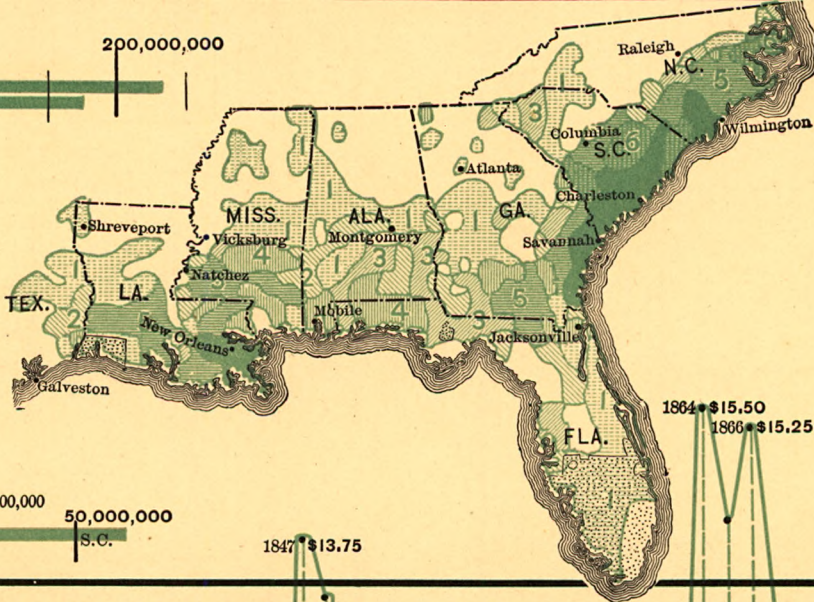

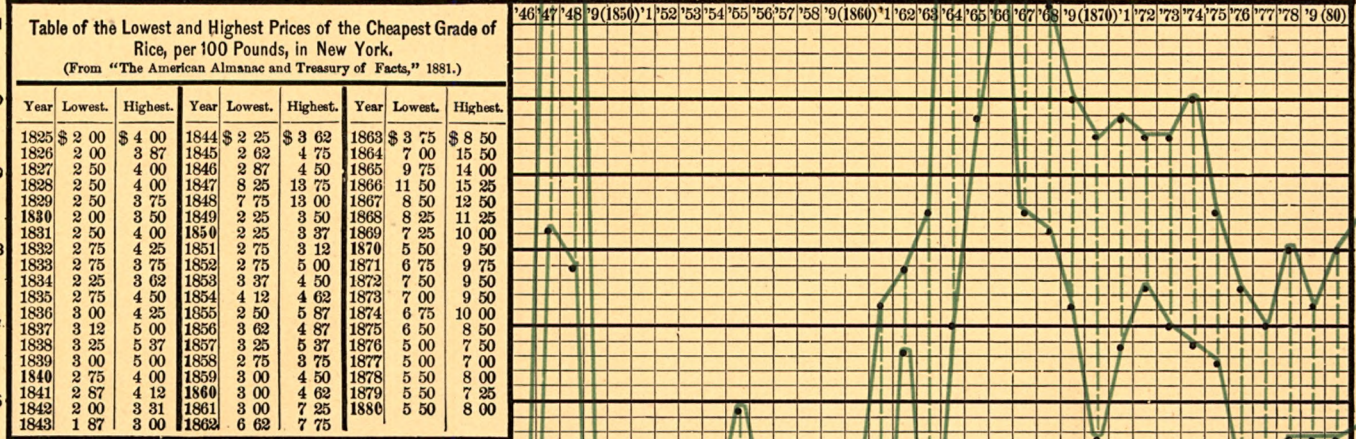


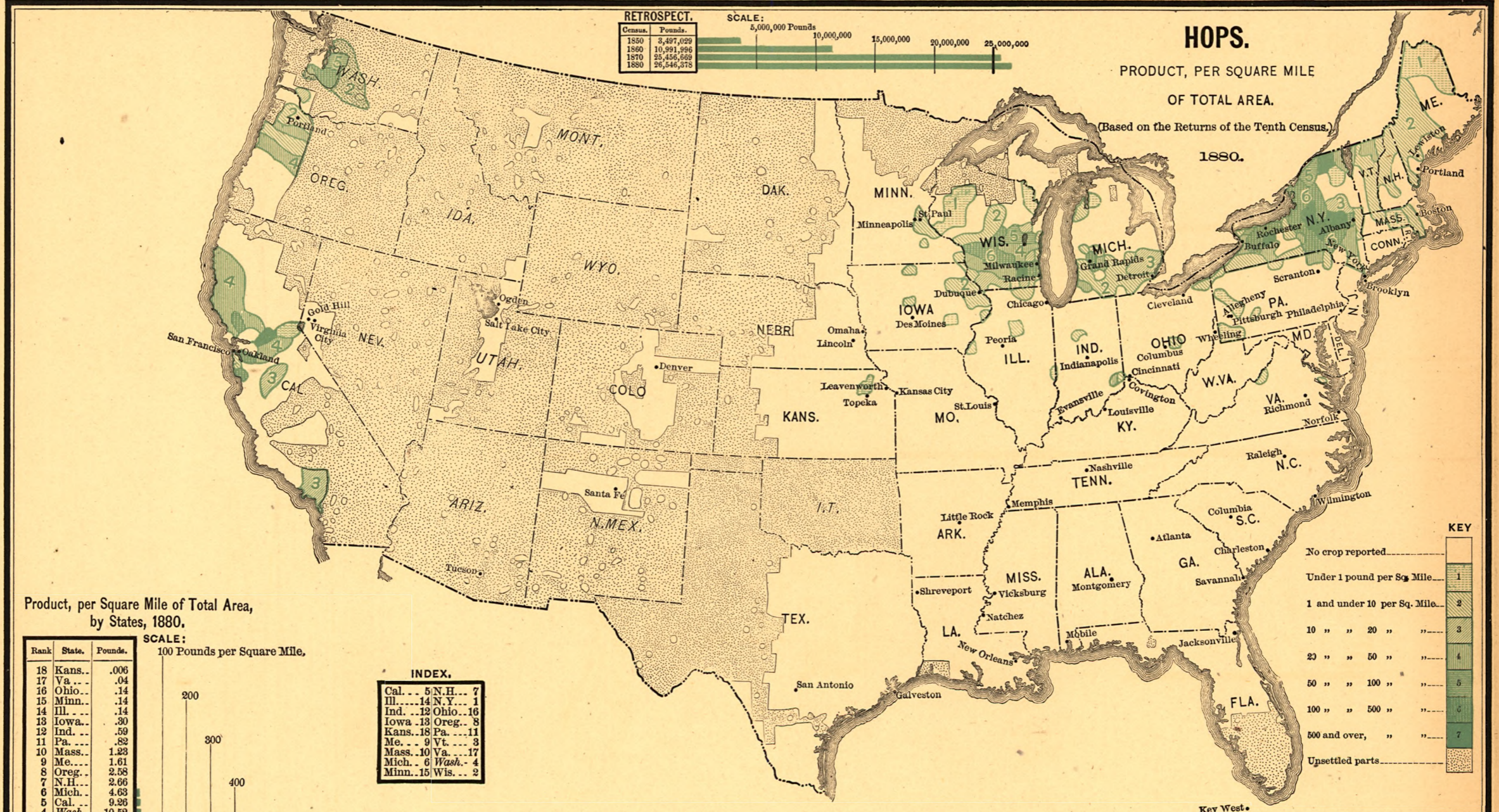

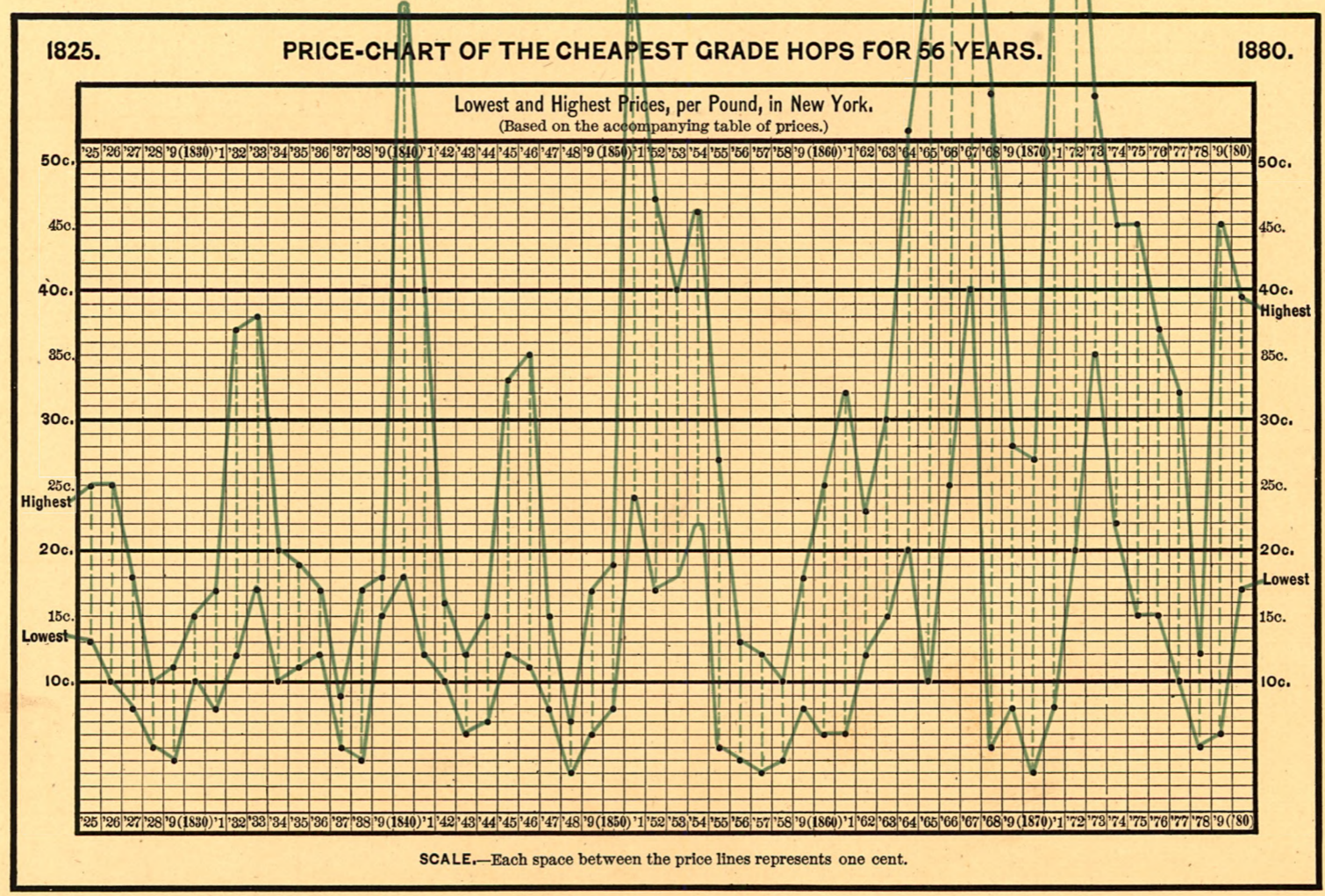

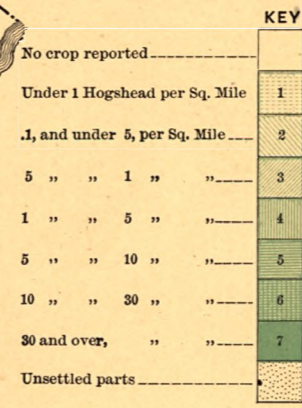

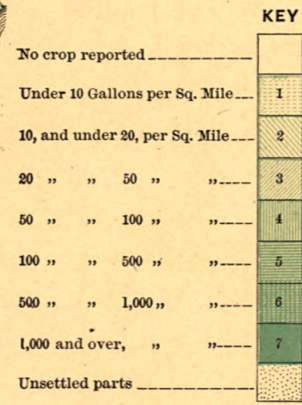
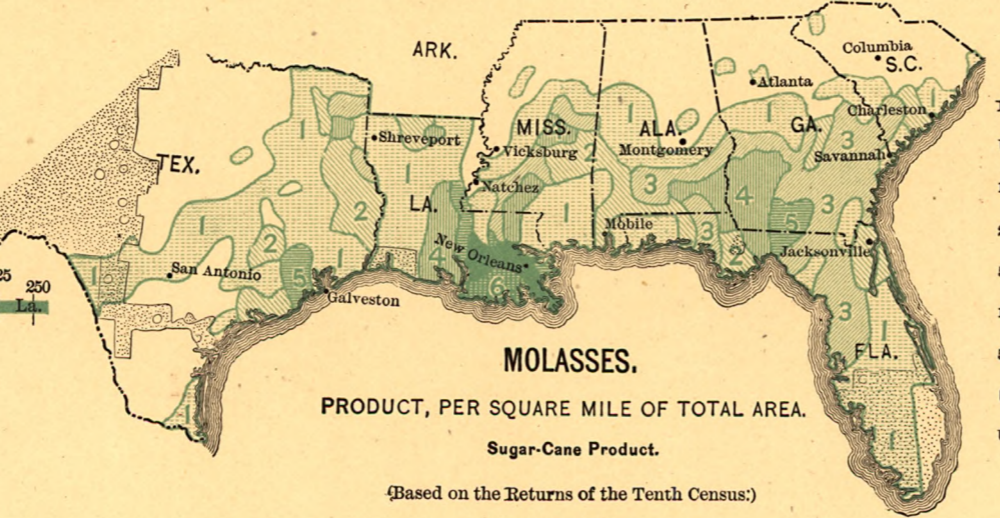
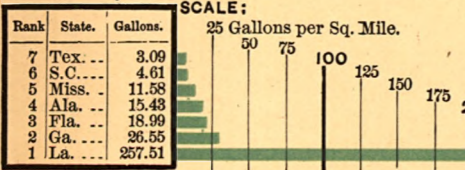
Product, per Square Mile of Total Area, by States, 1880.



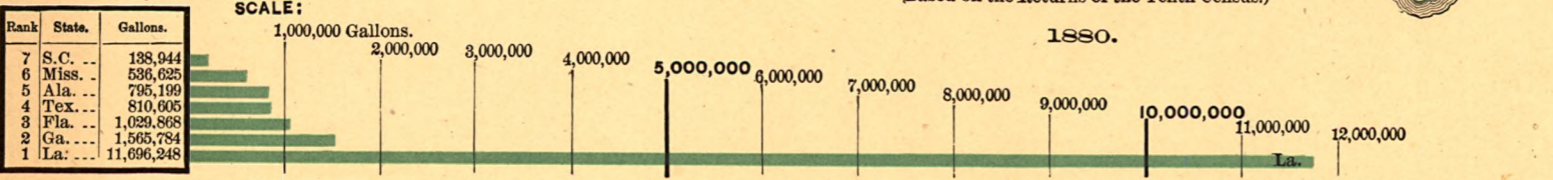
Total Product, by States, 1880.

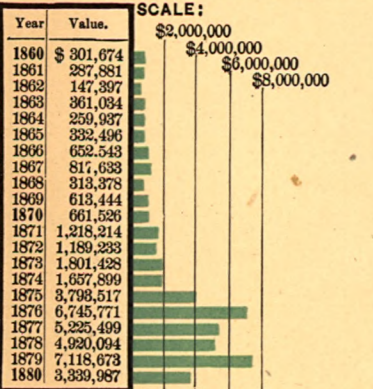

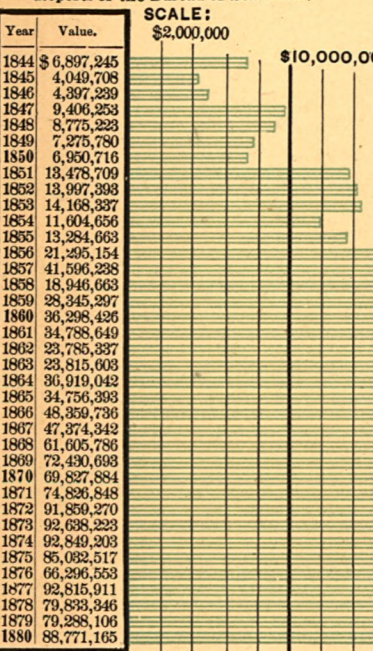

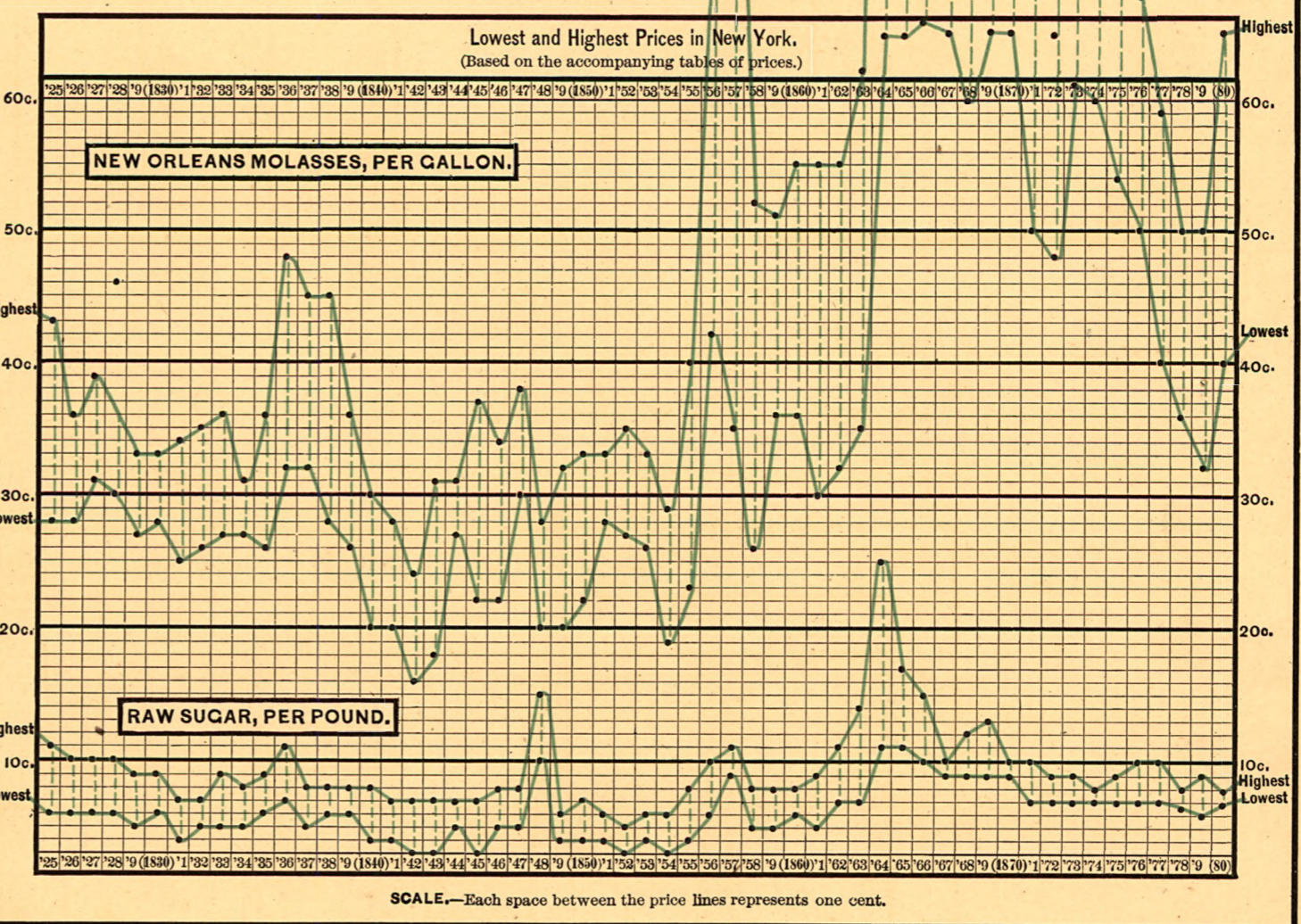
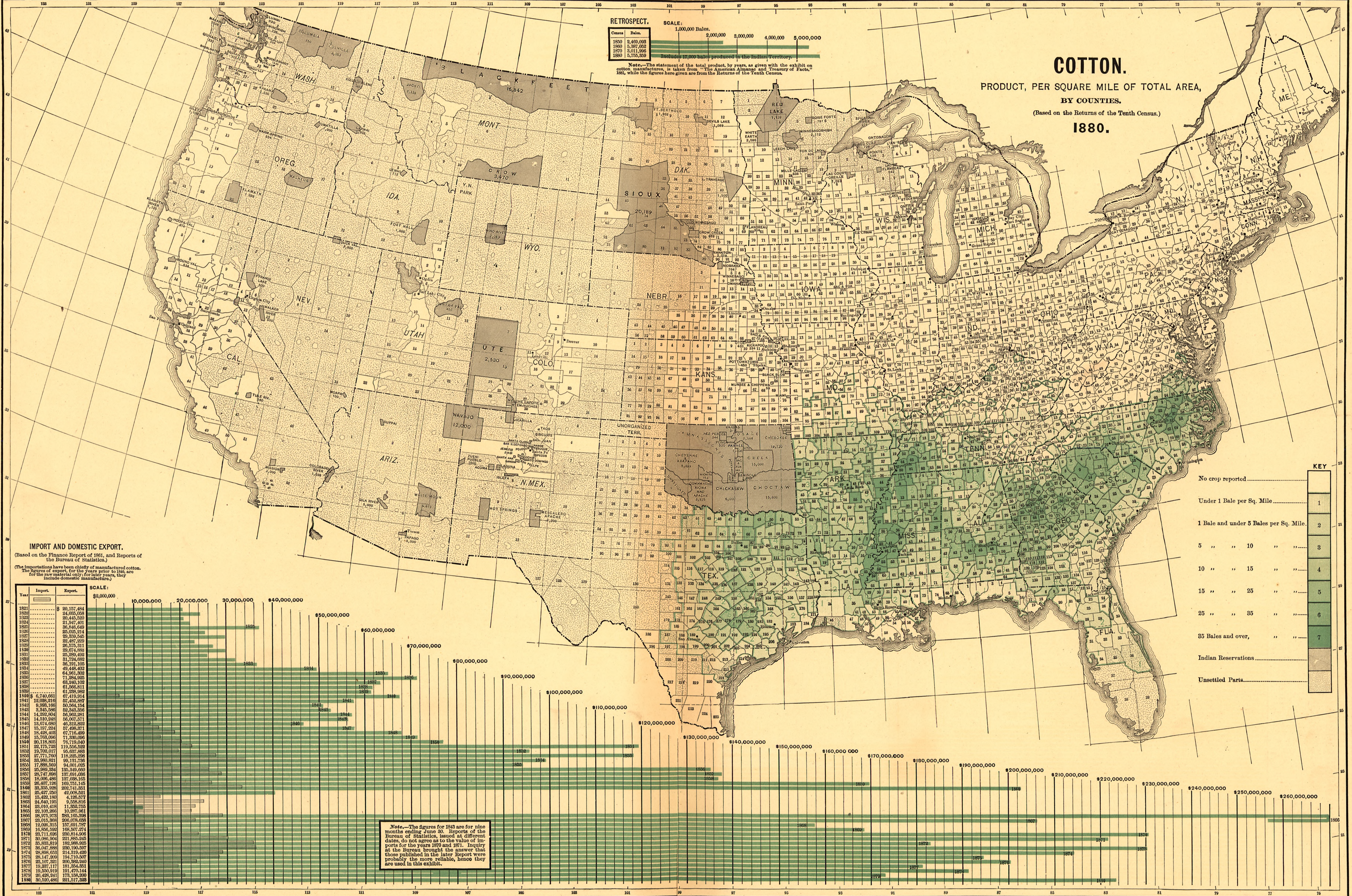

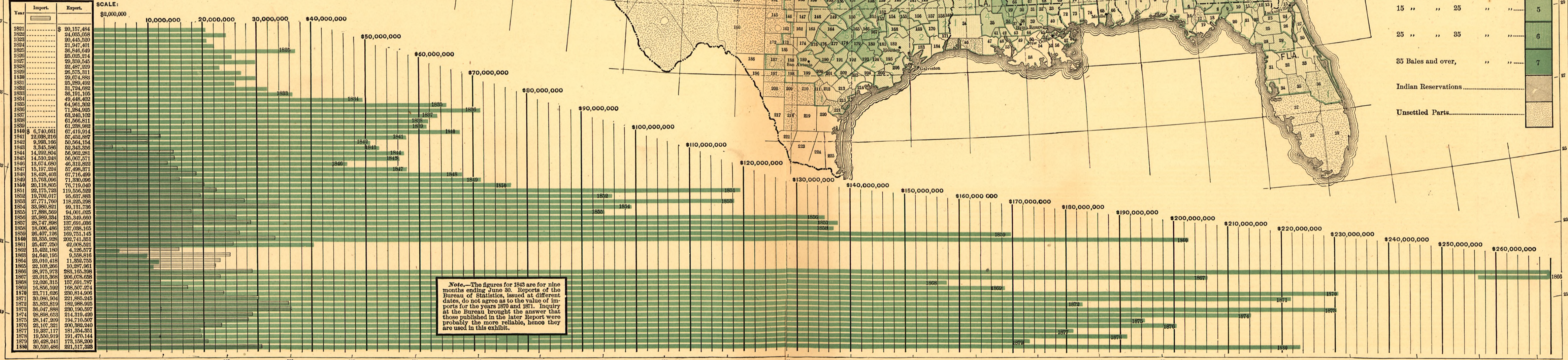

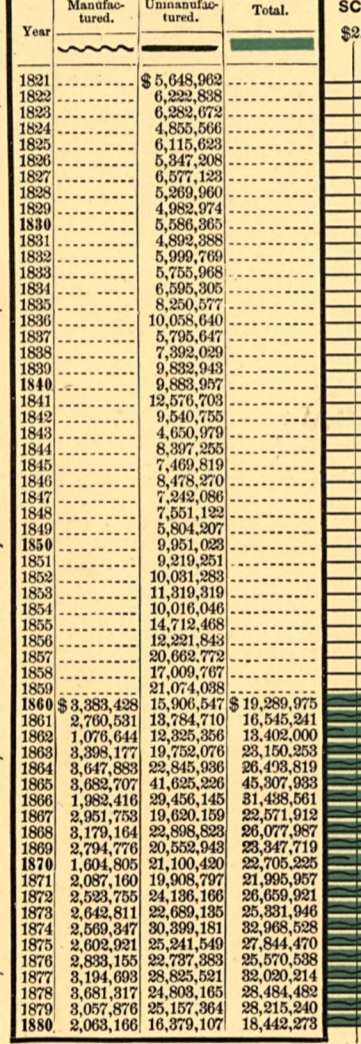
PRODUCT, PER SQUARE MILE OF TOTAL AREA, BY COUNTIES.

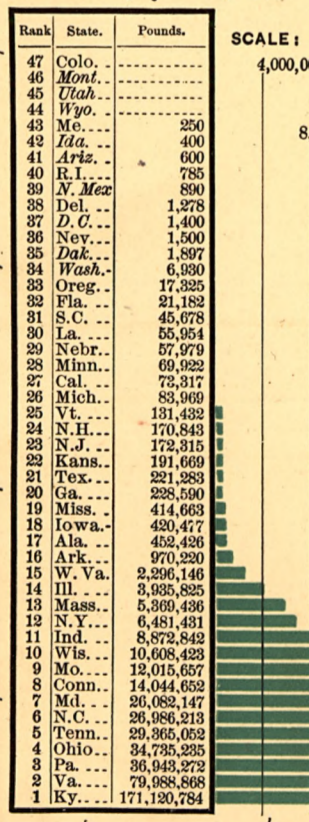

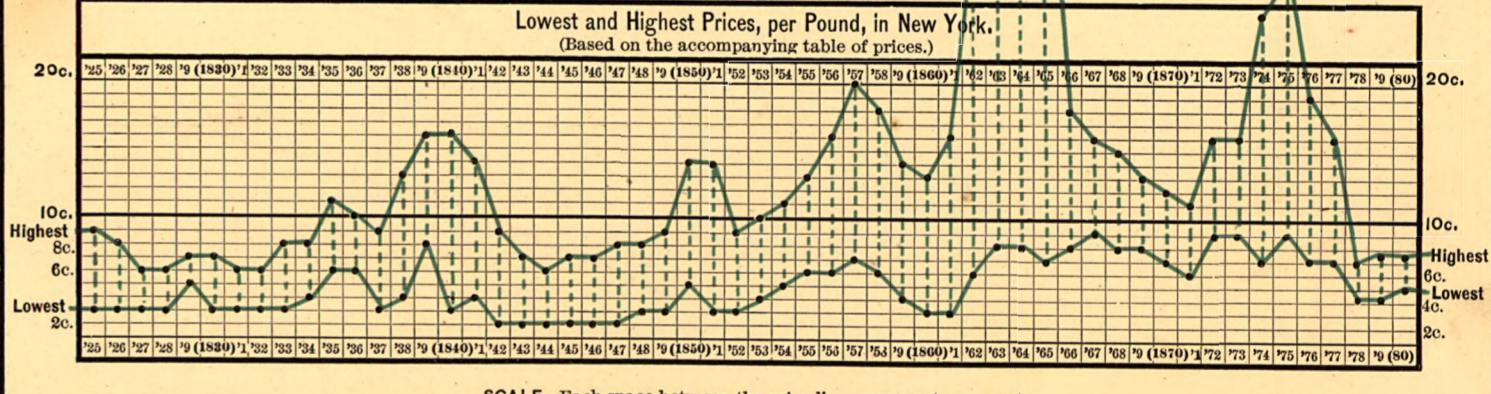
