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




1. PROPORTION OF WORLD'S MILL SUPPLY OF COTTON CONTRIBUTED BY EACH COUNTRY: 1922.



2. PROPORTION OF TOTAL CONSUMPTION OF COTTON, BY COUNTRIES, YEAR ENDING JULY 31, 1923.




3. COTTON PRODUCTION IN SPECIFIED YEARS: 1790-1922.





COTTON-PRODUCING AREA OF THE UNITED STATES IN 1922, AND CENTER OF PRODUCTION: 1859, 1879, 1906, 1910, 1912, 1914, 1916, 1918, 1919, AND 1922.

The center of production in 1859 was approximately 13 miles southeast of Macon, in Noxubee County, Miss.; in 1879 it was 11 miles south of Columbus, in Lowndes County; in 1906 it was 5 miles northeast of Mayersville, in Issaquena County; in 1910 it was 3 miles southwest of Vaiden, in Carroll County; in 1912 it was 2 miles north of Midnight, in Sharkey County; in 1914 it was 1 mile northwest of Sharpsburg, in Madison County; in 1916 it was 16 miles southeast of Arcola, in Washington County; in 1918 it was 6 miles southeast of Sturgis, in Oktibbeha County; in 1919 it was 5.6 miles northeast of Greenwood, in Leflore County, Miss.; and in 1922 it was 5 miles east by north of Lake Village, in Chicot County, Ark.






















COTTON GINNED, BY COUNTIES: 1922.



PER CENT OF COTTON GROWN IN EACH STATE, CROP OF 1922.




1. COTTON GINNINGS TO SPECIFIED DATES: 1905-1922.








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
COTTON CONSUMED, BY MONTHS: SEPTEMBER, 1912, TO JULY, 1923.
