The money stock averaged \$216.9 billion in the four weeks ending February 24, up at a 4.9 per cent annual rate in the past five months (page 5). Since February 1970 money has grown at a 6.1 per cent annual rate, which is as great or greater than 92 per cent of all other consecutive twelve month periods since January 1950. By comparison, money grew 3 per cent in 1969 and at a 3.1 per cent trend rate from 1957 to 1968.

Other aggregates, which largely determine the growth trend of money, have risen more rapidly than money in the past twelve months. The monetary base has increased at a 7.5 per cent annual rate since February 1970, while its largest source component, Federal Reserve credit, has increased at a 9.0 per cent rate (page 2). For short periods of time the base may grow at a different rate than money. Since February 1970 the rapid growth of time deposits has lowered the base multiplier, resulting in the slower growth in money than the base.

Most short-term market interest rates have continued to decline in recent weeks, and in general are at their lowest levels in six to seven years (pages 10 and 11). Yields on three-month Treasury bills averaged 3.35 per cent in the three days ending March 3, compared with 4.84 per cent in early January 1971 and 7.87 per cent in January 1970. Secondary market 90-day CD's rates averaged 4.04 per cent in the week ending March 3, down from 5.64 per cent in early January 1971 and 8.44 per cent a year earlier.

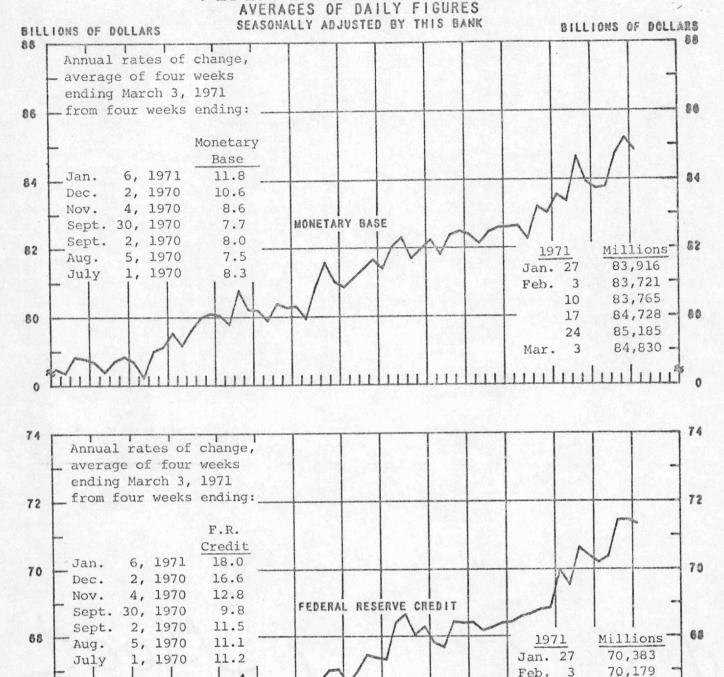
The Federal funds rate, the interest rate charged on very short-term lending from one bank to another, averaged about 3.20 per cent over the past two weeks. In comparison, this rate averaged about 4 per cent from mid-January through early February, about 5 per cent in December 1970, and about 9 per cent a year ago.

Long-term interest rates, however, have stopped declining in recent weeks, and some have risen slightly. Yields on seasoned corporate Aaa bonds averaged 7.12 per cent in the three days ending March 3, compared with 7.06 per cent three weeks earlier. Rates on new corporate issues have risen even more in recent weeks. Long-term Government bond rates averaged 5.94 per cent this week, 16 basis points above three weeks earlier.

Weekly data on Federal Reserve credit and monetary base have been revised. The revision resulted from the annual review of weekly seasonal adjustment factors. Back data of these series are available from this Bank on request.

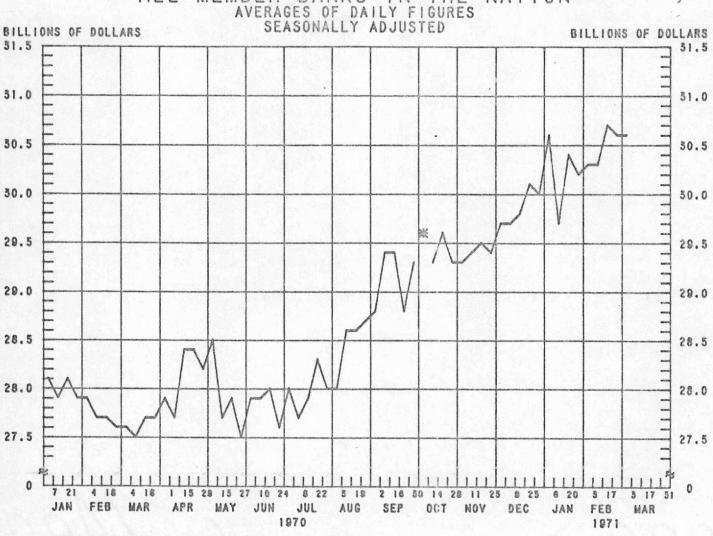

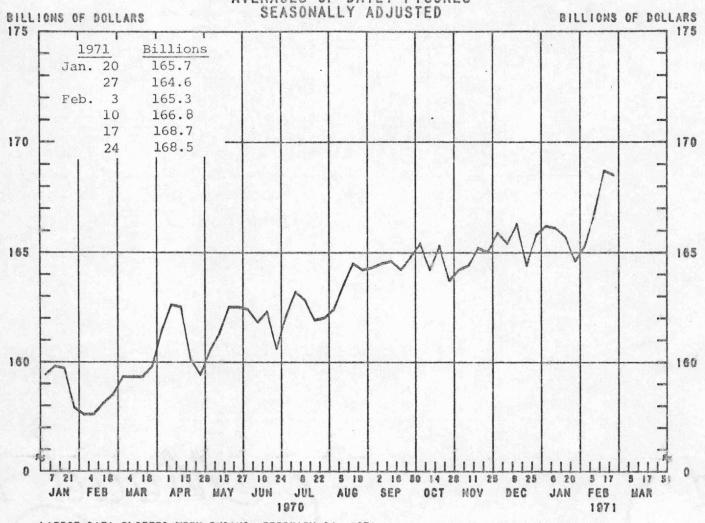

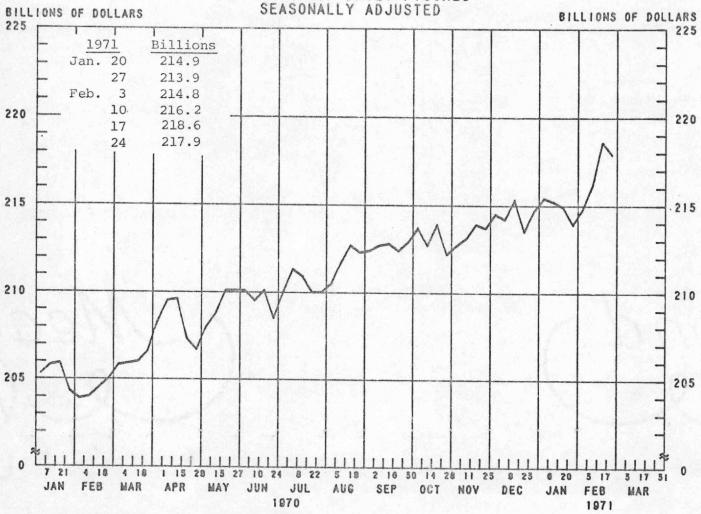

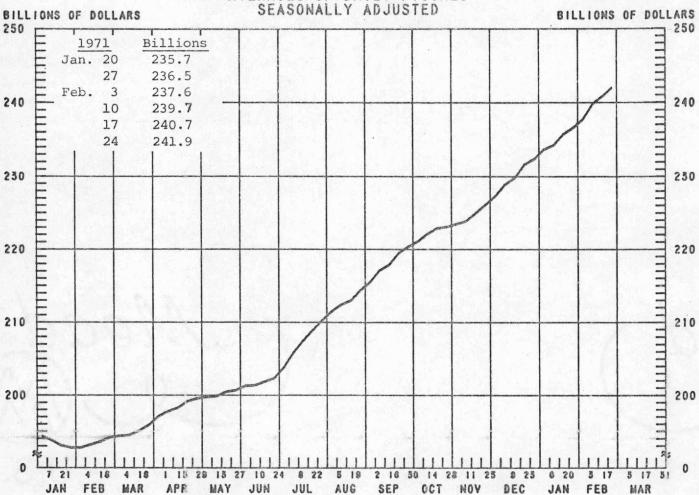

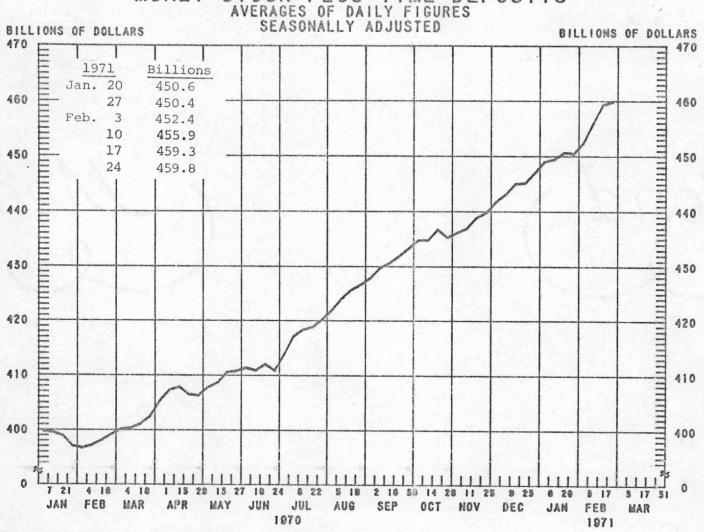

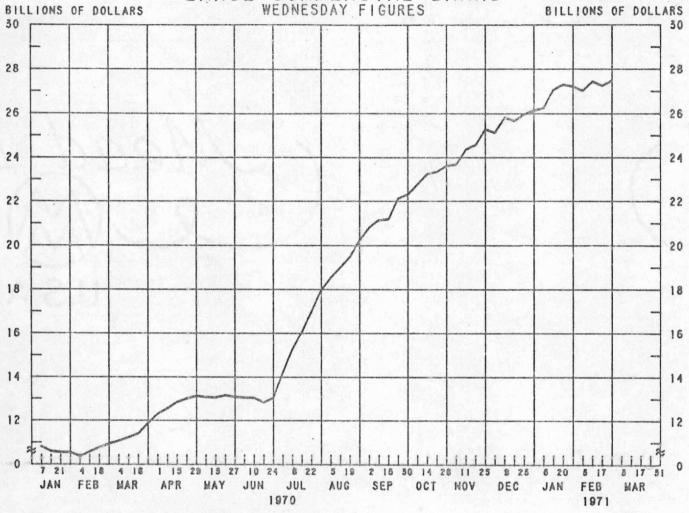
MONEY STOCK PLUS TIME DEPOSITS

CERTIFICATES OF DEPOSIT LARGE COMMERCIAL BANKS



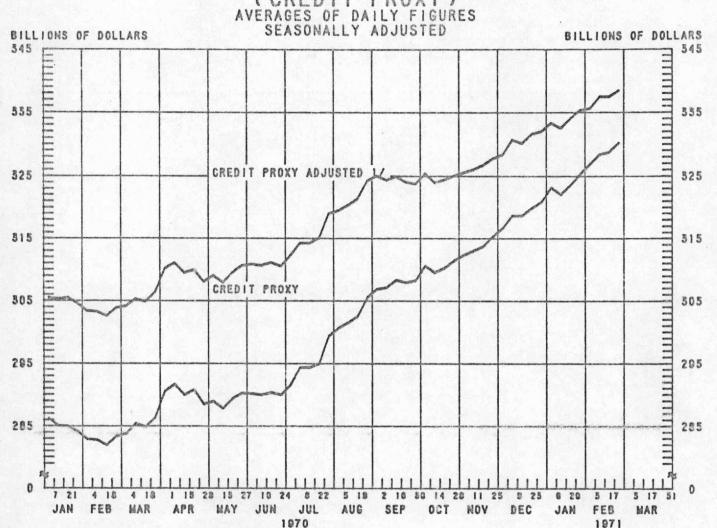

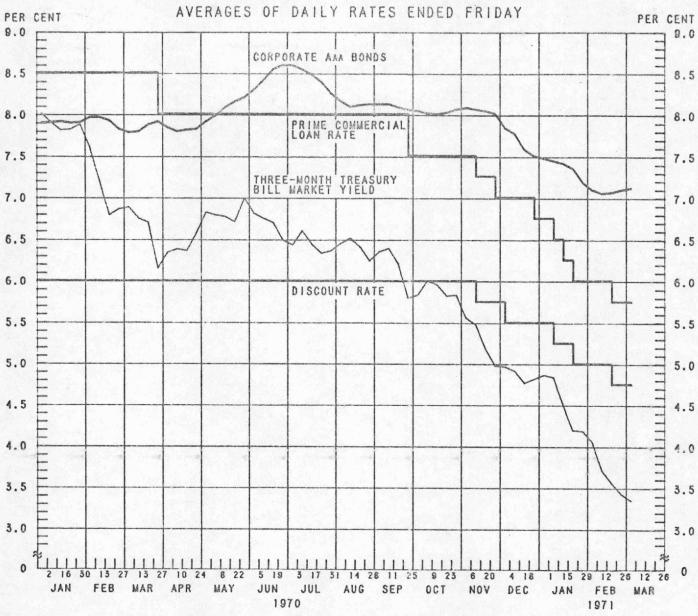

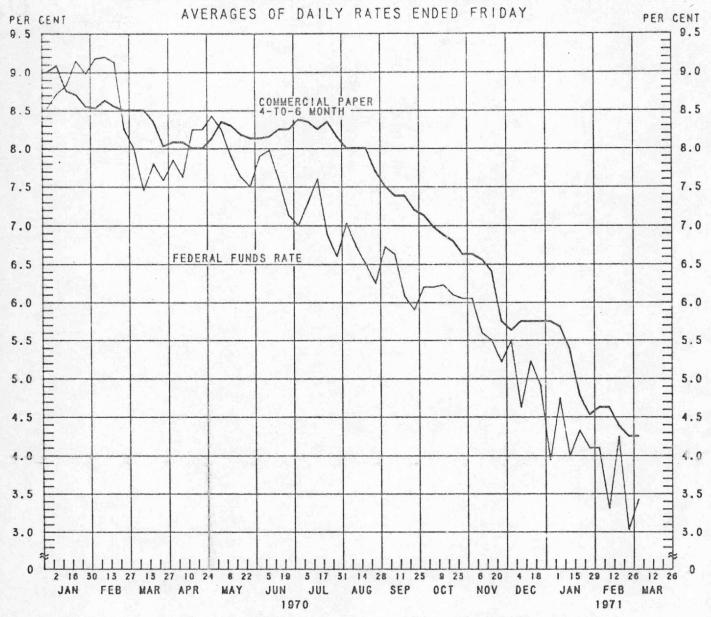

SELECTED SHORT-TERM INTEREST RATES



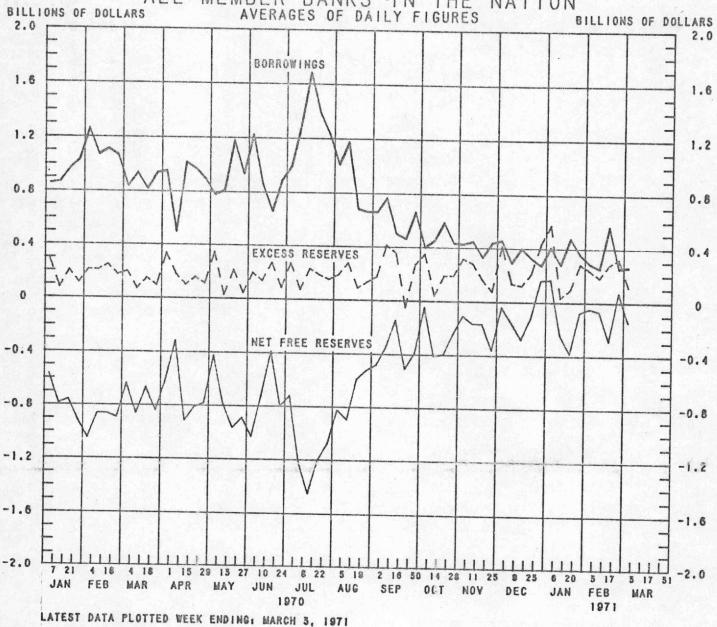
