The money supply (private demand deposits and currency held by the public) has increased at an 8.7 per cent annual rate from the four weeks ending December 9 to the four weeks ending April 7, compared with about a 6 per cent rate in the previous nine months and a 3 per cent rate in 1969 (page 5). The rate of growth in the last four months is above the 5 per cent average rate of growth since mid-1964. As the U. S. Treasury has drawn down its balances at commercial banks recently, the money supply may have grown more rapidly than otherwise would have occurred. When Treasury balances return to a higher level, the rate of growth of the privately held money supply may decline.


Total time deposits (page 6) have risen at about a 25 per cent annual rate since February 1970 and at an even faster rate since December. From September 1970 to December 1970 total time deposits increased \$12 billion, while from December 1970 to March 1971 they increased \$16 billion. The components of this monetary aggregate have shown opposite changes in their rates of expansion. The increase in large CD's has slowed from a rise of \$4 billion in the September to December period to a rise of \$3 billion in the December to March period, and the increase in net time deposits (total time deposits less large CD's) has accelerated from an increase of \$8 billion in the earlier period to an increase of \$13 billion in the later period.


Short- and intermediate-term market interest rates have risen in recent weeks but remain substantially below their early 1971 levels (pages 10 and 11). The Federal funds rate rose to an average of 4.03 per cent in the past four weeks, compared with an average of 3.47 per cent in the preceding four week period and a 4.14 per cent average in January. Prime bankers' acceptances rose to 4.38 per cent in the three days ending April 14, about 65 basis points above the early March level. Most short-term government securities were about one-half percentage point higher in the three days ending April 14 than in early March. Three-month Treasury bills currently yield 4.01 per cent, up from an average yield of 3.30 per cent in early March.

AVERAGES OF DAILY FIGURES







DEMAND DEPOSIT COMPONENT OF MONEY STOCK AVERAGES OF DAILY FIGURES







TIME DEPOSITS ALL COMMERCIAL BANKS AVERAGES OF DAILY FIGURES SEASONALLY ADJUSTED








