

Week ending: June 14, 1972

The money stock averaged \$236.1 billion in the four weeks ending June 7, up at an 8.6 percent annual rate in the past five months. Although this increase has been rapid, it follows five months of little growth and is less rapid than in the same period a year earlier. Overall, money has increased 5.2 percent in the past year, compared with 7.3 percent in the previous year and a 5.9 percent trend growth rate from late 1966 to late 1971.

Accompanying the growth of money in the past five months has been an acceleration in the growth of reserve aggregates. Reserves available to support private nonbank deposits have increased at a 9.8 percent annual rate in the past five months, considerably faster than the 3.7 percent rate in the previous five months. At the February meeting of the Federal Open Market Committee, this new reserve aggregate series was adopted by the Committee for stating its short-run reserve objectives. At the previous meeting, the Committee decided to place more emphasis on reserves as an operating target. More emphasis on reserve aggregates in policy implementation is expected to provide better control over monetary aggregates.

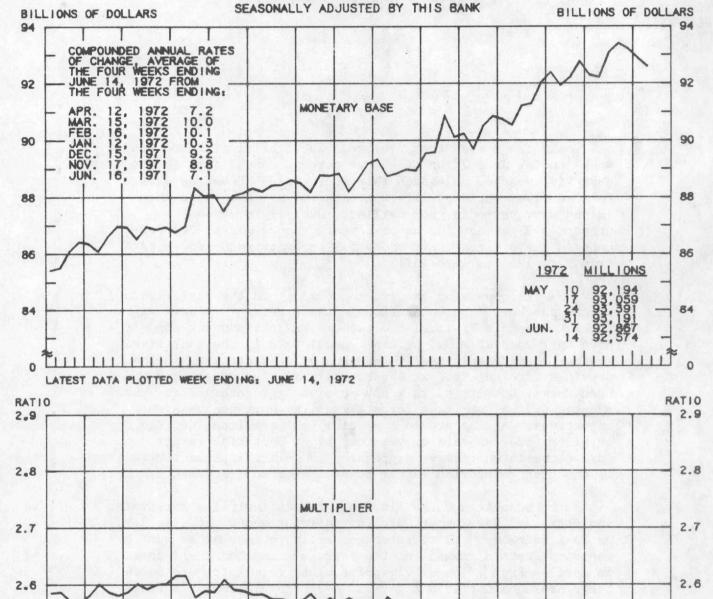
Long-term market interest rates, including corporate, municipal and Government, are currently at about the same level as last December. These rates generally rose somewhat during the first several months of the year, and reached their peaks in April. From a longer viewpoint, long-term rates are below their averages for 1970 and 1971. For example, Moody's Index of 20 Municipal bonds averaged 5.31 percent on Thursday of last week, down about 25 basis points from mid-April, and about the same as early December. For comparison this rate averaged 6.35 percent in 1970. Seasoned Aaa bonds averaged 7.25 percent in the first of this week, down slightly from the end of April, and the same as the December level. Rates on these securities averaged 8.04 percent in 1970.

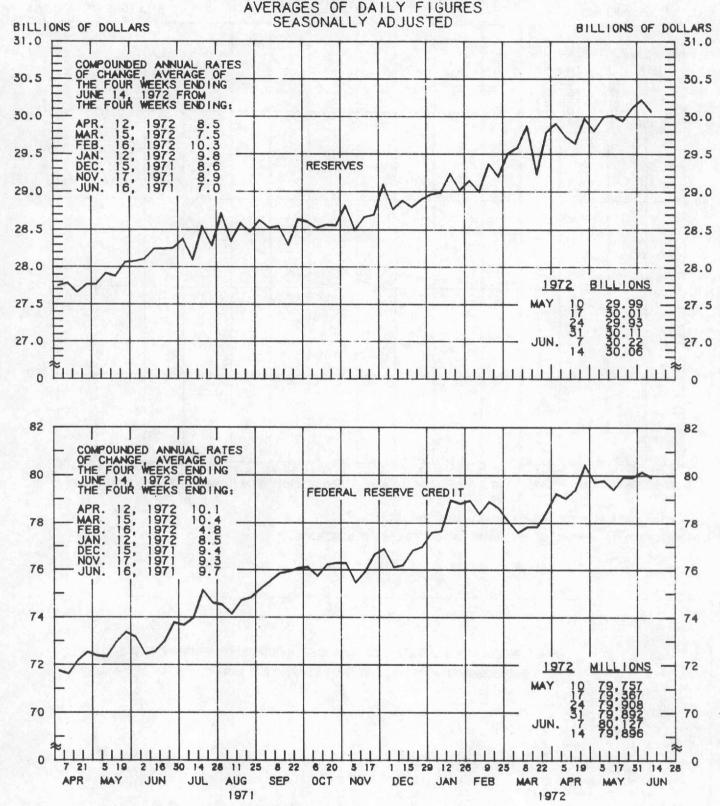

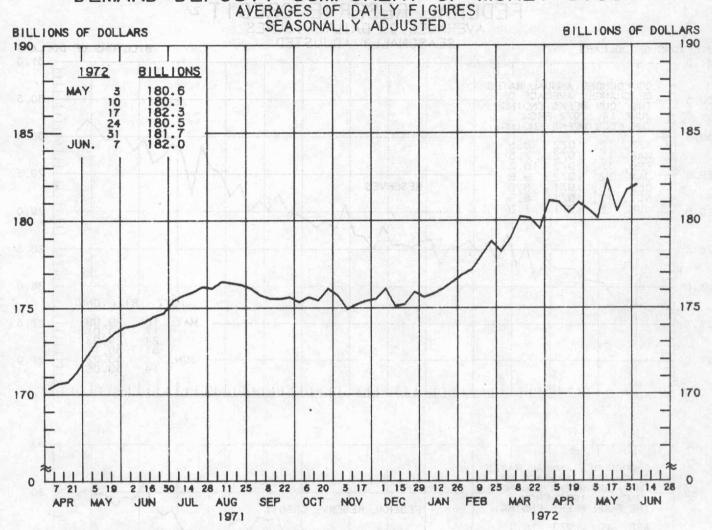

### DEMAND DEPOSIT COMPONENT OF MONEY STOCK

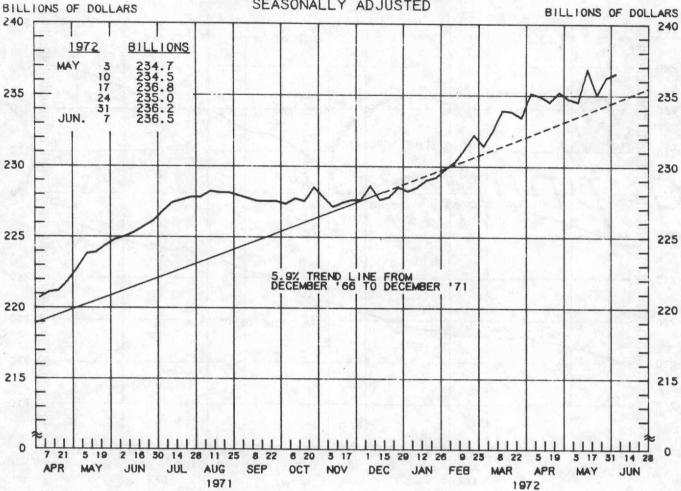

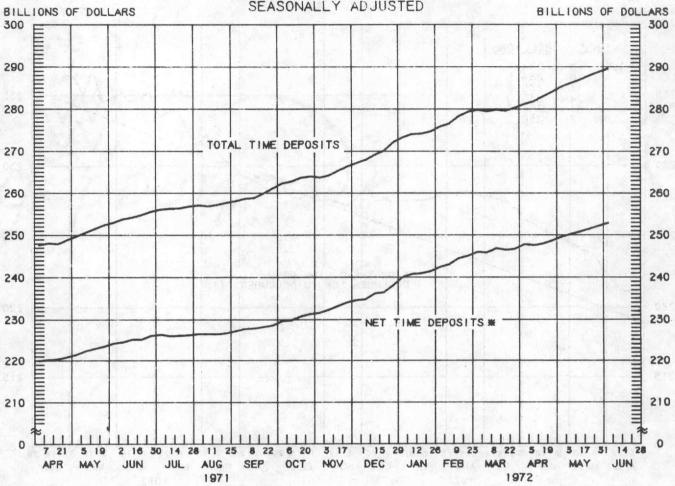

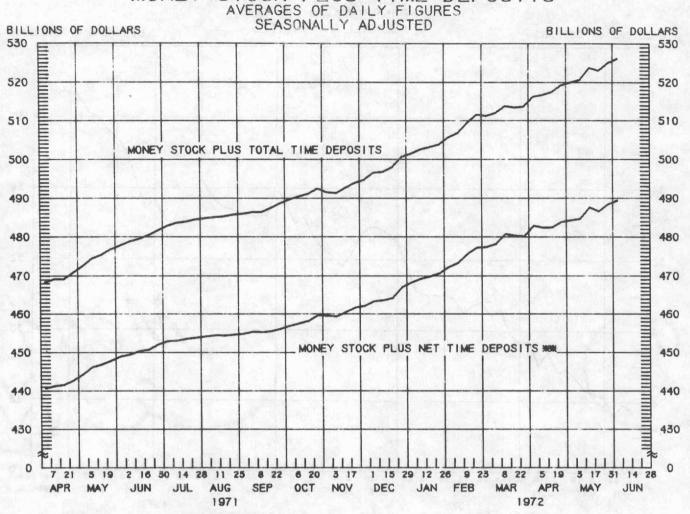

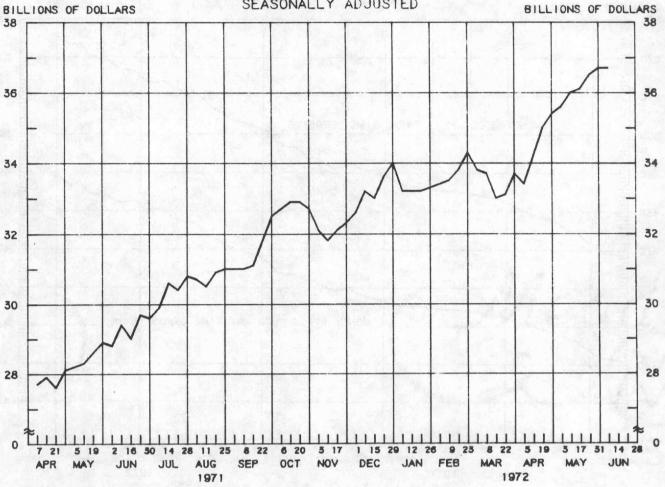

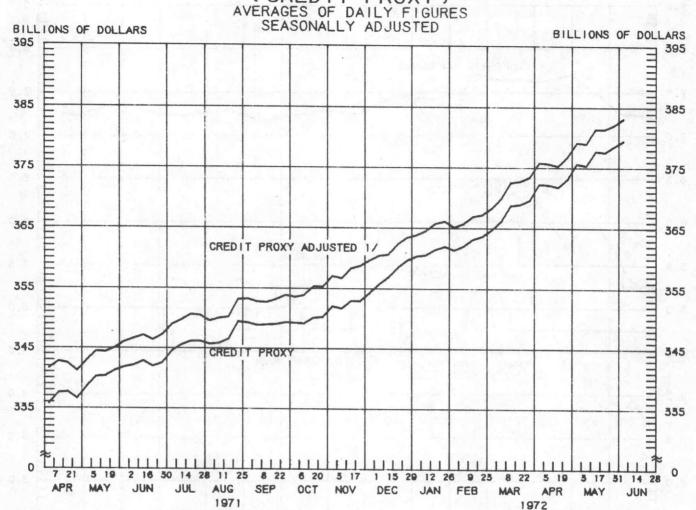

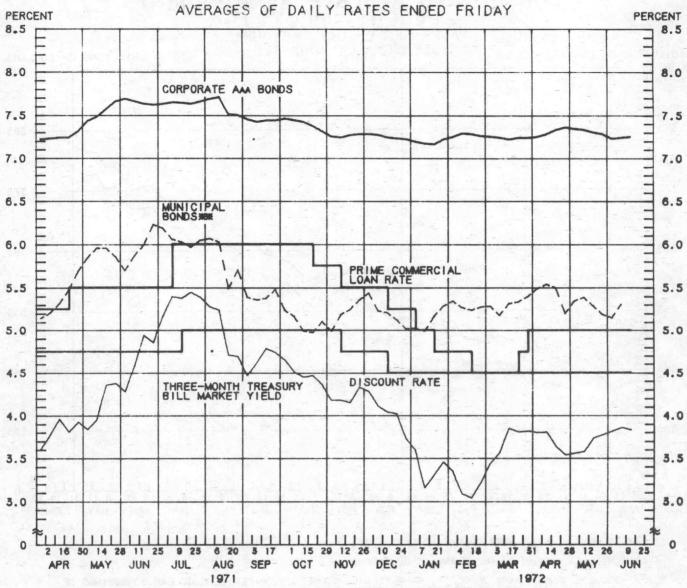

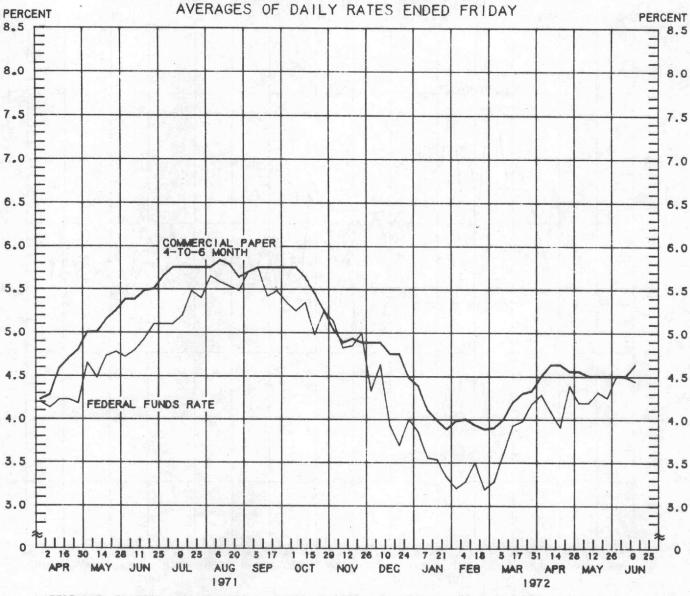

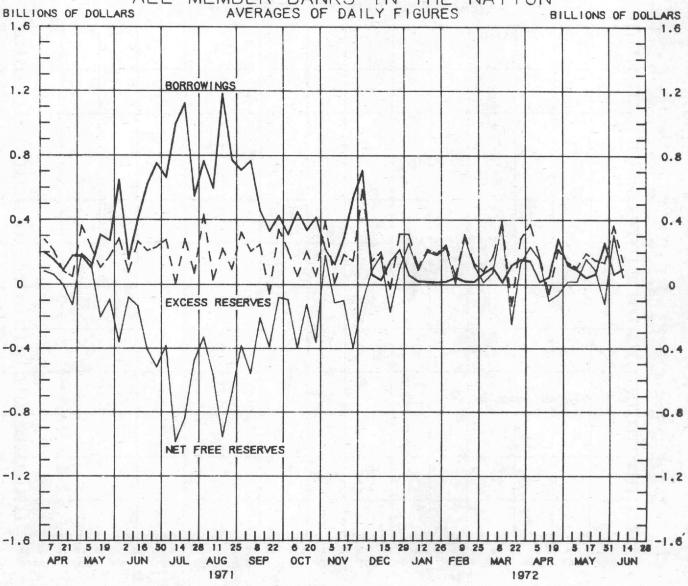
