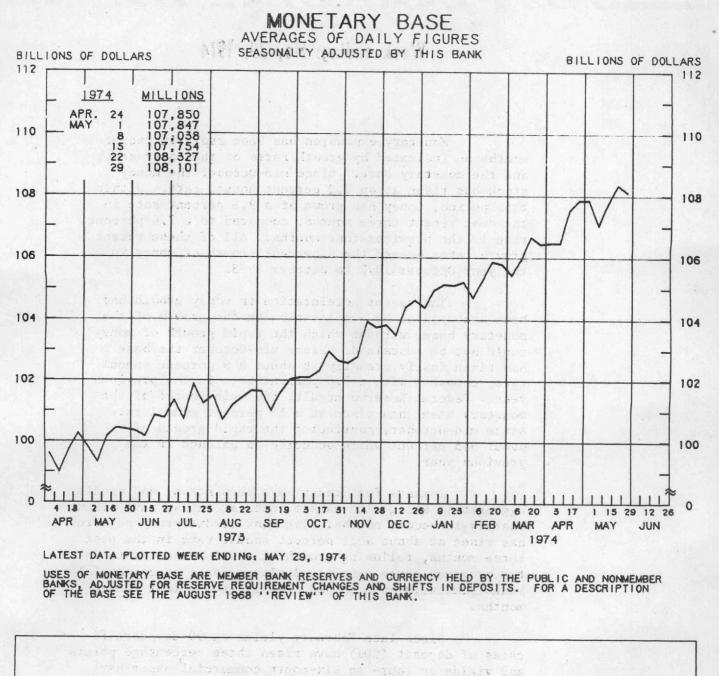

Monetary expansion has been rapid in recent months as indicated by growth rates of the money stock and the monetary base. Since mid-October the money stock has risen at an 8.3 percent annual rate. Within this period, money has grown at a 9.6 percent rate in the most recent three months, compared to a 7.4 percent rate in the previous four months. All of these recent growth rates exceed the 6 percent growth of money in the year October 1972 to October 1973.

The recent acceleration in money growth has been accompanied by acceleration in the growth of the monetary base, without which the rapid growth of money could not be sustained. Since mid-October the base has risen fairly steadily at about a 9 percent annual rate, compared with a 7.6 percent rate in the previous year. Federal Reserve credit, the main source of the monetary base, has risen at a 10 percent annual rate since mid-October, continuing the rapid growth of about 9.5 percent which occurred on balance in the previous year.

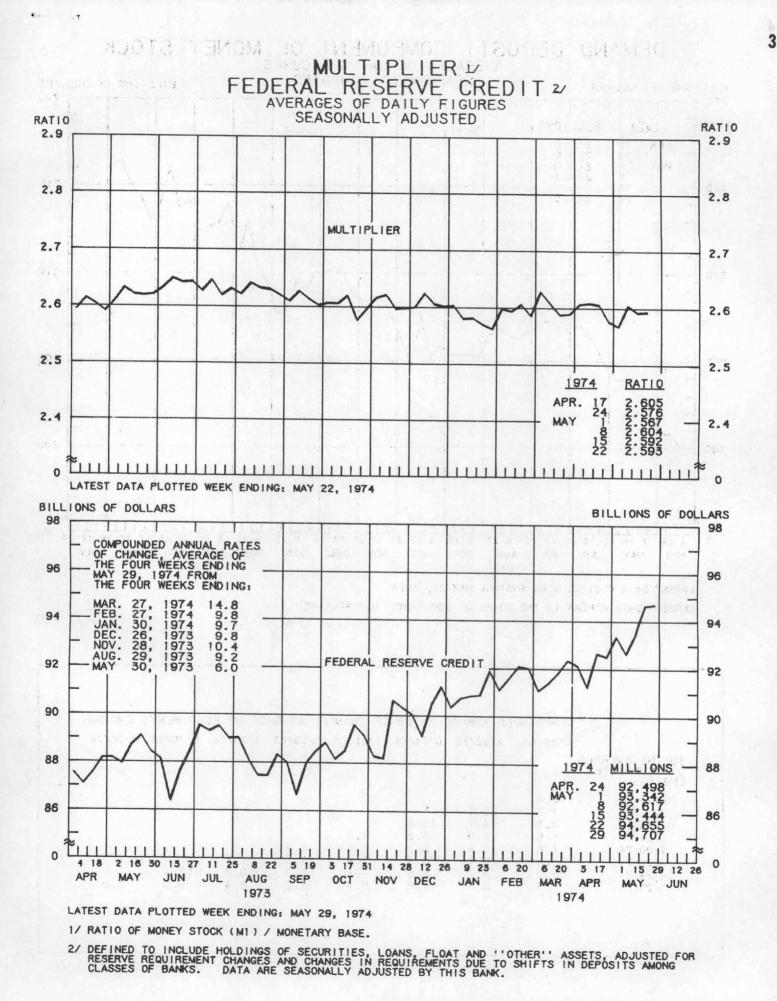
Demands for credit have been strong and credit aggregates, along with market interest rates, have risen sharply in recent months. The bank credit proxy adjusted has risen at about a 21 percent annual rate in the past three months, following growth at a 6.6 percent rate in the previous three months. Business loans at commercial banks similarly have jumped sharply in the last three months.

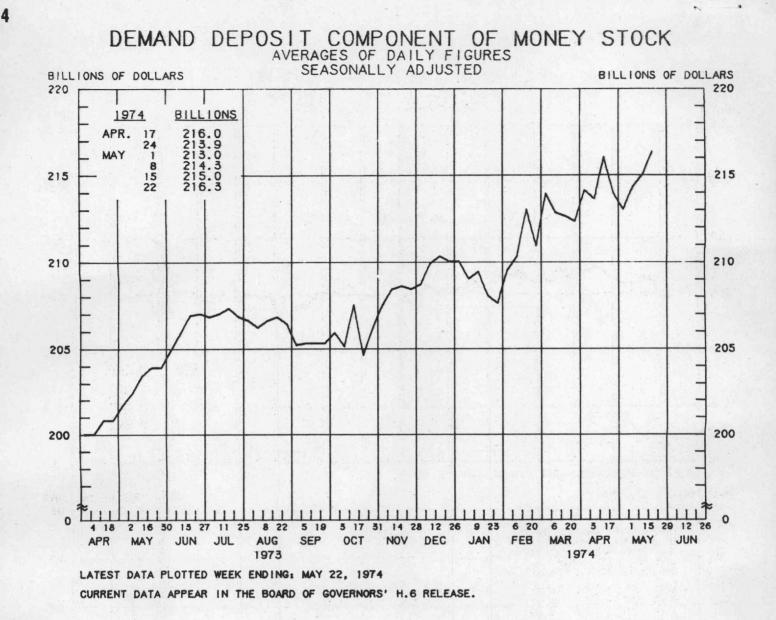
Since late February yields on 90-day certificates of deposit (CDs) have risen three percentage points and yields on four- to six-month commercial paper have risen about two and one-half percentage points on balance. Rates on 90-day CDs averaged 11.07 percent recently, while rates on commercial paper averaged 10.25 percent and the prime bank lending rate was 11.5 percent. Long-term interest rates also have risen substantially since late February. Yields on corporate Aaa bonds averaged 8.38 percent recently, up from 7.87 percent in late February.
